DAY 2

EXPLORE LIMA WITH OUR OUTSTANDING CITY TOURS!

Pick-up from your accommodation followed by a tour of Lima, featuring a visit to the Miraflores district. You will have the opportunity to experience the enchanting Love Park and the renowned sculpture "The Kiss," which provides panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean.

Next, we will embark on a panoramic tour of Huaca Pucllana, an intriguing pre-Incan archaeological site. Additionally, we will explore the exclusive El Olivar Forest in San Isidro.

Next, we will delve into Lima's Historic Center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Our itinerary includes Plaza San Martín, encircled by colonial architecture; Jirón de la Unión, a pedestrian thoroughfare rich in history; the Church of La Merced, a quintessential representation of Lima's Baroque style; and Plaza Mayor, which houses Lima's Cathedral and the Government Palace.

The tour will conclude at the Monastery of San Francisco, renowned for its catacombs and historic library. Subsequently, we will proceed to the airport for our flight to the city of Cusco.



CUSCO TOUR +4 INCA RUINS.

You have a free morning. At 12:20, I will collect you from your hotel to commence a guided tour of the historic city of Cusco, during which we will visit the Plaza de Armas, the Cathedral, and the Temple of the Sun.

Subsequently, we will depart the city to explore the Inca sites of Qenqo, Tambomachay, Puca Pucará, and the formidable fortress of Sacsayhuamán.

- **Qenqo:** This archaeological site showcases intriguing carved rock formations and subterranean channels, which are thought to have been utilized by the Incas for ceremonial and religious purposes.
- **Tambomachay,** often referred to as the "Inca Baths," is distinguished by its water sources that served ritualistic and purifying purposes. The site's architecture and hydraulic engineering are exceptionally noteworthy.
- **Puca Pucará:** This historic military fortress safeguards the entrance to Cusco and is distinguished by its reddish stones.
- **Sacsayhuamán:** This remarkable fortress is distinguished by its massive, meticulously carved stones that constitute its walls. It also provides sweeping vistas of Cusco.

At the conclusion of the visit, we will return to the city of Cusco.

SACRED VALLEY OF THE INCAS.

Following breakfast at 7:20 a.m., we will be collected from the hotel to commence our excursion to the Sacred Valley of the Incas, which features a collection of charming villages, agricultural terraces, and archaeological sites. We will have the chance to negotiate with vendors and explore the traditional indigenous market of Pisac, where a Catholic mass will be held on Sunday in Quechua, the native language.

Lunch will be held at a local restaurant in the Sacred Valley. In the afternoon, we will traverse the towns of Calca and Urubamba before reaching the Inca Fortress and Citadel of Ollantaytambo, constructed to safeguard the entrance to this segment of the valley from potential threats originating from the lowland jungle. This remarkable edifice comprises a series of superimposed terraces of hewn stones, accessible via extensive staircases. We will have the opportunity to wander through the enchanting streets of the adjacent town, which served as a religious and agricultural hub during the Inca Empire, thereby enhancing our understanding of the military strategies employed against possible invasions. On our return to Cusco, we will explore the picturesque Andean village of Chinchero, home to the remnants of the royal estate of Túpac Inca Yupanqui. There, we can admire the well-preserved Inca wall in the main square and visit the exquisite colonial church constructed on Inca foundations, which features captivating frescoes in its portico.

At the conclusion of the visit, we will escort you back to the city of Cusco.

MARAS SALT MINES EXCURSION.

MARAS AND MORAY EXCURSION.

Pickup from your hotel to begin a day immersed in the rich cultural and historical heritage of the Cusco region, beginning with a visit to Maras and Moray. This tour provides a fascinating insight into the Inca legacy and the impressive majesty of the Peruvian Andes.

- Maras Salt Mines: The journey begins at the Maras Salt Mines, an extraordinary landscape of terraced salt mines that have been in operation since pre-Inca times. Located in the heart of the Sacred Valley, these salt pools form a captivating white mosaic that contrasts with the green mountains. Here, you'll discover the traditional methods of salt harvesting that have survived and the importance of this resource to the local economy.
- Moray Archaeological Site: Next, you'll head to Moray, an intriguing archaeological site featuring a series of circular terraced depressions. It is believed to have functioned as an Inca agricultural laboratory, as its unique design generates diverse microclimates, allowing for experimentation with different crops. This site not only provides a glimpse into the past but also offers panoramic views of the surrounding Andean landscape.

Throughout this tour, an expert guide will accompany you, providing in-depth commentary on the region's history, culture, and natural wonders. This half-day excursion from Cusco is a journey through time and nature, revealing the ingenious practices of the ancient Incas and the timeless beauty of the Andes. At the end of the day, you will return to Cusco, where you can enjoy a free evening.



MACHUPICCHU EXCURSION

After breakfast, we will head to the train station to begin our journey to Aguas Calientes (Machu Picchu Pueblo). From there, we will board the shuttle bus that takes us up to the Machu Picchu citadel—one of the wonders of the world and among South America's most impressive archaeological sites.

The guided tour of Machu Picchu will follow the specific circuit and entry time selected when the tickets were purchased. Since different tour routes offer unique perspectives and access to various sectors of the citadel, the final itinerary will depend on official availability and the specific ticket type purchased.

During the tour, our guide will share insights into the history, architecture, culture, and spiritual significance of Machu Picchu as we explore its main areas and take in the spectacular Andean scenery.

After the tour, we will descend by bus to Aguas Calientes, where we will have free time for lunch and to enjoy the town before catching the return train.

Important: Machu Picchu tickets are limited and subject to availability. To secure your preferred circuit and entry time, we recommend booking at least 4 to 5 months in advance, especially during peak travel seasons. The specific circuit, entry time, and visit conditions will depend on official availability at the time the reservation is confirmed.



RAINBOW MOUNTAIN HIKE

4:30 a.m. Our exhilarating day will commence with a pickup from your hotel as we embark on our journey to the stunning Rainbow Mountain from Cusco. We will travel south for roughly two hours on a comfortable tourist bus to the delightful town of Cusipata, where we will savor a delectable breakfast to ready ourselves for the day ahead.

Following breakfast, we will embark on a one-hour journey to the trailhead known as Phulawasipata, where our hike will commence. This trek will last approximately 1.5 to 2 hours until we arrive at Vinicunca Pass, the renowned viewpoint overlooking Rainbow Mountain. Throughout the journey, we will have the chance to admire the stunning landscapes typical of the Andes, along with its rich flora and fauna, particularly the llamas and alpacas, which enhance the experience.

Subsequently, we will retrace our steps along the same route back to the starting point of our hike (Phulawasipata), where our transportation will be ready to take us back to Cusipata. In Cusipata, we will savor a delightful buffet lunch to restore our energy for the remainder of the day. Following lunch, we will commence our return journey to Cusco, where we will spend the night.

Upon our arrival in Cusco, the evening will be free, allowing us the opportunity to explore and appreciate the city's beauty at our leisure, uncovering its charms and immersing ourselves in its vibrant culture.
