Producer / Director

For this obs-doc series looking at the life of truckers, I filmed with contributors with whom I had to quickly build a close relationship, This resulted in them speaking openly about a number of issues - including mental health and suicide.

- Managed all editorial elements of output and oversaw staffing, budgets and development of individual team members.

Self-shooting Director

- Pitched, researched, wrote, self-shot, and edit produced short films.
 - The success of my films, and filming style, resulted in the Series Editor asking me to single-handedly re-shoot The One Show's main title sequence.
- Stories ranged from current affairs, to art, history, consumer issues, and food.

 Spent a week embedded in a rehabilitation centre for ex-servicemen suffering from PTSD, producing a series of obs-doc films, capturing engaging, emotional moments – from a non-invasive viewpoint.
