



Tim Burr - President/Founder



Tim Burr crashed backcountry skiing, broke his neck, sustained a spinal cord injury, and was paralyzed from the chest down in 2014 when he was 19 years old. Before that, Tim lived in Glenwood Springs and Gunnison, Colorado where he participated, and in some cases competed, in outdoor sports including freestyle skiing, mtn biking, dirt biking, kayaking, and SUPing. After breaking his neck, Tim recognized a new passion of exploring the outdoors through offroad adaptive driving that led him to start Return to Dirt. Return to Dirt is a nonprofit that, “puts disabled individuals behind the wheel of their own adventure” by sharing adapted off-road vehicles with people that have mobility impairments that limit their outdoor recreation (spinal cord injuries, traumatic brain injuries, cerebral palsy, amputees, Multiple Sclerosis, etc). Now Tim runs day to day Return to Dirt operations, drives as often as possible, fly-fishes, and does physical therapy on a weekly basis.
