Over the past month, our grassroots coalition has been hard at work defending the land, legacy, and future of Waller County. Here's what has happened:

Government & Agency Outreach

- Presented at Waller County Commissioners Court meeting (June 11) to voice community concerns.
- Delivered formal communications to city, county and state officials, the General Land Office (GLO), Alamo Trust, Texas Historical Commission, TCEQ, and TxDOT, urging critical review should permit requests related to TexasLand USA be submitted.

Public Awareness & Literature Distribution

- Distributed flyers, brochures, and yard signs door-to-door across the county.
- Delivered banners and informational materials to supporters and key locations.
- Worked to increase local visibility through community outreach and signage.

Media & Website Updates

- Published letters and announcements in local media (*Waller County Express* and *Waller Times*). Extra media outreach continues for deeper reach into the area.
- Launched and expanded our online store to support fundraising and awareness efforts.
- Added expanded content to our website (www.cdwallerco.org) to reflect the timeline and facts behind HB 5685 and the TexasLand USA project.

- Designed and mailed flyers, postcards, and press kits to supporters and media contacts across Texas and beyond.
