

**NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM USE OF ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM**

In connection with an election to be held on May 2, 2026, NOTICE IS GIVEN that each of the political subdivisions listed in this Notice intends to hold the election without providing a voting station that meets the requirements for accessibility under 42 U.S.C. Section 15481(a)(3) either on election day or during the period for early voting by personal appearance.

However, any voter in a political subdivision listed in this Notice may request the use of a voting station that meets the accessibility requirements for voting by a person with a disability, and the political subdivision will comply with such request if it is received no later than the 45<sup>th</sup> day before the date of the election. **NOTICE OF DISTRICT PETITION TCEQ INTERNAL CONTROL NO. D-12182025-029**

**PETITION.** Tango Lima Bravo Oscar, LLC, a Texas limited liability company, (Petitioner) filed a petition for creation of Brazos River Improvement District (District) with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). The petition was filed pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59 of the Constitution of the State of Texas; Chapter 375, Texas Local Government Code; Chapter 49 of the Texas Water Code; Title 30, Chapter 293 of the Texas Administrative Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ.

The petition states that: (1) the Petitioner holds title to a majority in value of the land to be included in the proposed District; (2) there are no lienholders on the property to be included in the proposed District; (3) the proposed District will contain approximately 227.19 acres located within Waller County, Texas; and (4) none of the land within the proposed District is within the corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction of any city.

The territory to be included in the proposed District is depicted in the vicinity map designated as Exhibit "A", which is attached to this document.

The petition further states that the proposed District will: (1) purchase, design, construct, acquire, maintain, own, operate, repair, improve and extend a waterworks and wastewater system for mixed used, entertainment, and commercial purposes; (2) construct, acquire, improve, extend, maintain, and operate works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances helpful or necessary to provide more adequate drainage for the proposed District; (3) control, abate, and amend local storm waters or other harmful excesses of waters; and (4) purchase, construct, acquire, maintain, own, operate, repair, improve, and extend such additional facilities, including parks and recreational facilities, roads, systems, plants, and enterprises as shall be consistent with all of the purposes for which the proposed District is created.

According to the petition, a preliminary investigation has been made to determine the cost of the project, and it is estimated by the Petitioner that the cost of said project will be approximately \$21,515,000 (\$14,355,000 for water, wastewater, and drainage, \$7,160,000 for roads).

**CONTESTED CASE HEARING.** The TCEQ may grant a contested case hearing on this petition if a written hearing request is filed within 30 days after the newspaper publication of this notice. To request a contested case hearing, you must submit the following: (1) your name (or for a group or association, an official representative), mailing address, daytime phone number, and fax number, if any; (2) the name of the Petitioners and the TCEQ Internal Control Number; (3) the statement "I/we request a contested case hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you would be affected by the petition in a way not common to the general public; and (5) the location of your property relative to the proposed District's boundaries. You may also submit your proposed adjustments to the petition which would satisfy your concerns. Requests for a contested case hearing must be submitted in writing to the Office of the Chief Clerk at the address provided in the information section below.


The Executive Director may approve the petition unless a written request for a contested case hearing is filed within 30 days after the newspaper publication of this notice. If a hearing request is filed, the Executive Director will not approve the petition and will forward the petition and hearing request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. If a contested case hearing is held, it

will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
