Shortly after, we admitted our new staff to our CORE x Staff program, which offers a way for students to get involved with the club by "interning" for our NSU CORE officers. We have also recently collaborated with UC Berkeley's Cal Japan Club to host our annual Halloween party and hope to collaborate with them again soon. The year has started off with a lot of fun and exciting moments, and we look forward to our continued engagement with UC Berkeley's Japanese American community!
