A Note from the Director

The musical Annie was performed at the Orpheum Theatre in Memphis, Tennessee, as part of its first national tour in 1980, with performances running from November 11 to November 22. Eight-year-old Daphne was in those seats, and the rest is history!

Since then I sang "Maybe" in a fourth grade showcase. I played Lily at West Memphis Little Theater (now the Little Theatre of Crittenden County) in 1996, then I directed it various versions of the show in 2006, 2016, and 2022.

This is the beginning of my 36th year of directing children, and it is my passion. I do this because I love to see that spark in their eye when it all comes together, when it all makes sense. Many of these children have never been on stage — couple those with some outstanding "veterans," and you have the making of a fabulous production. I got to see them blossom before my eyes; I pushed them and they rose to the occasion!

And here we are, in our second year on our biggest stage yet, the Heindl!! These kids deserve this stage! I say I don't do children's theatre, I do theatre that happens to have kids in it! It's amazing what they can do when given the opportunity!

Of course, I do none of this without the help of a group of quite talented young actors and an amazing production team, some of which I must personally thank.

First, I would like to say thank you to this cast of children for their hard work and determination to get it right! I am so very proud of each and every one of you. You each bring your own unique talents to this show! You are all important to this production and to this organization.

Parents, thank you for sitting in the parking lot waiting on your kid to get out of rehearsal. Thank you for being patient and letting your kids say "just wait 'til the show." Thank you for supporting and encouraging your child. Most of all, thank you for sharing your children with me! You will be amazed at what they have done!

Mandy, Dawn, Ron and Makesha: you have taken my thoughts and our conversations and turned them into the perfect set for our cast! Your attention to detail has made it what it is! I am so thankful for you all! You are amazing humans.

Susan, my choreographer and friend, I am so grateful that we see things the same way. Thank you for never expecting any less just because they are kids. Thank you for some amazing moves! This cast is having so much fun performing your dances.

Our board, Susan, Anna, and Lindsay: Thank you for coming along on this crazy journey with me! Your support and encouragement means to world to me! You are always open with an ear, you play devil's advocate, and you always ask "What can I do?" Thank you!

My daughter, Madison: You were the first one to say, "Do it!" You are the face behind our social media and website. You make it all look good! You have been my biggest advocate for this thing I do I guess because you were a product of it — one of your first roles was an orphan in Annie when you were six, then Rooster and Miss Hannigan! You taught choreography, painted and designed sets, made props, ran sound, stage managed, and counseled lots of kids. You did it all really! Oh, and you write speeches that make your momma cry like a baby. I guess you just know how many kids just like you need it. MSACT would not have existed without you.

My son Matthew, the man behind the sound! He grew up on my stages as well! He is an amazing character actor who has played Daddy Warbucks and Rooster — twice — and he just happens to be home for a gap year! I am honored that he chooses to spend his time with us and these kids!

To the audience: "when you're stuck with a day that's gray and lonely, just stick out your chin and grin and say.." Sing with us, laugh with us, support these amazing kids! They deserve it.



ABOUT THE MID-SOUTH ACADEMY FOR CHILDREN'S THEATRICS

Our founder and executive director, Daphne Cox, has been doing this for a long time. She directed her first youth production at only 18 years old, and for the past 33 years, she has continued to use her immense experience to share her passion for performing with children wherever she can reach them. She has directed main stage youth productions in West Memphis, AR, Memphis, TN, Hernando, MS, and more across the Mid-South; directed two- to three-week intensive summer camps several years in a row; led after-school theatre classes for the past ten years; and even brought up her own, now adult, children in the wonderful world of theatre.

But of course, she couldn't stop there. Daphne — with the help of long-time friend, collaborator, and fellow Mid-South theatre veteran Susan Zeringue — set out to start her own business from scratch, a weekly after-school and homeschool program for varying levels of experience known as the Dramatic Repertory Association for Music and Arts (DRAMA), to not only continue connecting with new generations of performers, but make great strides toward accomplishing her lifelong dream: establishing a children's theater.

"We aren't in the business of making stars," Daphne often said to describe the goal of DRAMA. To Daphne, teaching children's theatre has never been about whether her students went on to win awards or perform on Broadway — though some certainly have, and she couldn't be prouder — it has always been about one thing: "We want children to have confidence in who they are."

We believe that everyone needs a safe place to learn what they love and discover who they are meant to be. They need a place to learn how to collaborate, how to solve problems, how to find confidence. We believe theatre should be a nurturing and accessible environment for individuals from all walks of life, and we want to provide an invaluable experience that our students may otherwise not have access to. We currently teach children ages 3-18 years skills such as teamwork, self-discipline, overcoming mistakes, public speaking, and much more all through the performing arts.

On May 17th, 2024, just over one year after DRAMA was born, the Mid-South Academy for Children's Theatrics officially launched, the next huge step in making her dream come true. With the endless support and efforts of those who now comprise our Board of Directors — many of whom are parents of students who have grown up under Daphne's direction — we embarked on the arduous but rewarding journey of establishing ourselves as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, which gives us access to many invaluable resources and opportunities to achieve our goals.
