"When we first moved to the Old South Side, we realized there was so much work to be done. Abandoned homes, problem rentals, and a crime spot at a gentlemen's club began negatively impacting our neighborhood. We needed to do something.

We all agreed that we needed to get organized to get attention and support from the city. So a group of concerned neighbors, business owners, local elected leaders went to City Hall.

The response wasn't what we were hoping for. They said, 'who would ever want to live in the Old South Side?'

We were just shocked. We thought if the city isn't going to help us, we'll do it ourselves, and we did.

With Justin's help, we made a plan and started working together to improve the neighborhood."

NIGHTCLUB SHUTDOWN

"It was through Justin's efforts that we managed to get that license revoked. Not only did we have to go to the city but we had to go to the State Alcohol Commission and it was soundly revoked by the State. That was our very first joint effort."

NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN UPS

"We combined our neighborhood groups to gain strength in numbers and started having regular cleanup projects to bring residents together. IMPD and our local elected officials, like Justin now attend our meetings to work on issues in our community."

TACKLING ABANDONED HOMES

"Justin was instrumental in creating the Blight Elimination Funding that helped us get abandoned homes torn down in our neighborhood. That was money well spent. Now, we've got just about all of those properties taken care of."



HOLDING SLUMLORDS ACCOUNTABLE

"One of the biggest problems our neighborhood has faced is problem landlords. Justin passed a law requiring all landlords, even out-of-state ones, to give the city their contact information so we could work with them to be better neighbors."



PROPERTY SHOWCASE EVENT

"We did a property showcase and brought in over 170 realtors and developers to see our neighborhood and that was the turning point. Justin was a big part of helping get the word out and making it such a success."



LIFT INDY GRANT

"Last year, our neighborhood was chosen by the city for a major investment in housing, infrastructure, and other quality of life areas. Now homes are being fixed up. It is just amazing how far we've come from that first meeting at City Hall."
