- Design and Functionality: Quality and creativity of design proposals.
- Project Management: Clear project plan and timeline.
- Technical Capabilities: Ability to meet technical requirements and deliver a robust CMS.
- Cost: Value for money and cost-effectiveness.
- References: Positive feedback from previous clients.
