Ms. Beyer is a 46-year-old female past medical history significant for multiple systems atrophy who is presenting to the ED with altered mentation. According to her husband at bedside she had an episode that he describes as a "coma" where she was essentially unresponsive and stiff as a board for approximately a 12-hour duration. Then she finally came to but secondary to her altered mentation as well as associated abdominal pain shortly thereafter they brought her in for further assessment. Work-up has been relatively benign. She denies any recent medication changes or alterations. She denies any recent illness. Her only complaint on assessment is that she has some localized tenderness with point palpation musculoskeletal he. She is slow to respond. According to her husband, this is at relative baseline.
