Proper noun

is the name of a specific person, place, event or thing and requires a capital letter

Noun

- a name given to people, things, places, events, qualities and ideas

Verb

is a 'doing' or 'being'
 ('being' - am, is, are, was, were, have, has, had)
 word

Adjective

give more information about pronouns and nouns

Adverb

- give extra meaning to a verb, adjective, another adverb or a whole sentence

time - now, then, yesterday
manner - slowly, hard, quietly
place - outside, everywhere
degree - very, quite, really

Determiner

- specify a noun a, an, the this, that, those my, your, his some, every

Preposition

- show time (at midnight/during the film/on Friday)
 - position (at the station/in a field)
 - -direction (to the station/over a fence)
 - relationship (with me, for the day)
 - cause/reason (because of, in spite of. instead of, due to)

Pronoun

- replace nouns

- replace nouns

I, you, he, she, it, me, him, her, we, they, us, them

possessive pronoun - mine, his/hers, yours, ours, theirs

relative pronoun - who, that, which, where, when, whose

Conjunction - connect words, phrases or clauses

Coordinating conjunction

- join words, phrases or clauses that are of equal status - and, but, so, or

Subordinating conjunction

join clauses that are not of equal status - because, if, although, since, before, as, while, whenever, once, when, after
