CONSTITUTION AND RULES

An abridged version; the Secretary holds the approved version that is open to any member of the club should he/she wish to see it.

Name The name of the Club shall be the Ramsdell Cricket Club.

Colours The Club colours shall be navy and light blue.

Aims and Objectives

The Aim of the Club shall be the playing and the promotion of the game of cricket, facilitating an environment whereby the game can be played and enjoyed. The Objective of the Club is to encourage the playing of recreational cricket through the provision of practice and playing facilities and competitive fixtures for all playing members.

Membership

Membership shall be open to all, irrespective of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, creed, colour, social status or sexual orientation. However, limitation of membership according to available facilities is allowable on a nondiscriminatory basis.

Subscriptions

The annual subscriptions for all members of the Club shall be recommended from time to time by the Management Committee and subject to approval by the members at the AGM. Members will be deemed members of the Club by virtue of their paid subscription for the ensuing year.

Member's subscription shall be due by the end of April or prior to inclusion in the first fixture.

Conduct, Behaviour and Discipline

Individual Members of the Club are responsible for their own behaviour and conduct such that the Club's reputation and good name is not brought into disrepute.

Notwithstanding the above, conduct, behaviour and discipline of any team playing under the Club's banner shall be the responsibility of the respective team Captain who shall ensure, to the best of their ability, that the game of cricket is played in accordance with the Laws of the game, as well as abiding by the spirit of the game. Where cases occur that cannot be resolved by the Captain, then he or she shall report the matter to any member of the Management Committee who will ensure the matter is brought to the attention of the full committee at the earliest opportunity and appropriate action taken.

Officers

The Officers of the Club shall consist of the President, Vice-Presidents and the elected Executive of the Management Committee.

Management

Day to day management of the business of the Club shall be vested in the Executive comprising the Chairman of the Management Committee, Secretary and Treasurer who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

Management Committee

The Management Committee shall consist of the Executive and others who have been formally co-opted onto the Committee. The Management Committee shall be empowered to set up such sub-committees as it thinks fit and seek to fill any vacancy arising within the Club.

A player's representative shall be invited to attend Committee Meetings at the discretion of the Chairman, ideally on a rotational basis.

The Management Committee shall meet as necessary and be responsible for the governance of the Club within the framework of these Rules and shall have the power to deal with anything not covered by the Rules and to decide on the interpretation of these Rules in the event of any disagreement as to their meaning. Any such decision shall be final and binding upon the members.

Any member of the Management Committee, by written notice given to the Secretary, may call a special meeting of the Management Committee at any time. At least 7 days' notice of a meeting of the Management Committee shall be given to its members, and the notice shall specify the business to be discussed.

A quorum will be any two of the Executive, plus a formally co-opted member of the Management Committee.

Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Club shall be held as soon as possible upon the conclusion of the previous season and no later than 30 November of that same year.

The purpose of the AGM shall be to review the season just concluded, to review the accounts for that financial year, to elect for the ensuing year the Executive and to transact any other business deemed relevant to the AGM.

Finance

The Management Committee are responsible for conducting the Club in a sound financial manner and shall accrue no debts or liabilities.

Winding Up

A resolution to dissolve the Club can only be passed at an Annual General Meeting or at any Extraordinary General Meeting through a 75% majority vote of those at the meeting who are fully paid-up members of the Club during in the cricket season preceding the calling of the EGM.

Cricket Code of Conduct

The Club and its members shall ensure that all members abide by the ECB Code of conduct, which incorporates the Spirit of Cricket and the Laws of Cricket.

General

No order for goods to be supplied, or for work to be done, shall be given only by an officer duly authorised by the Management Committee.

Members are expected to assist in the preservation of the property of the Club and any member wilfully damaging such property shall be required to make good such damage at their own cost.
