

### 2020 Large Trash Collection

Members who own property in McHenry and Brown Townships. (Information is from the respective township websites.)

Brown Township holds "Clean-up" days at the Route 414 site on the second Saturday of May and November from 10am – 2pm, accepting furniture, bedding, carpet, etc., appliances (units with freon - \$20.00 charge, tires \$4.00 each). Limit one pick-up truck load per property, additional loads will be \$20.00 each. The township is no longer able to accept any type of electronics, TV's. DVD or Video players. These items may be taken to Wayne Township Landfill, McElhatten or the Transfer Station on West Third Street, Williamsport.

**McHenry Township** holds "White Goods Collection Day" (appliances only) at the recycling center in Watson Township. Township also hosts a "Large Item Collection Day" accepting furniture, bedding, carpet, etc., tires \$4.00 each in Mid-May at the site in Cammal. The township is no longer able to accept any type of electronics, TV's. DVD or Video players. These items may be taken to Wayne Township Landfill, McElhatten or the Transfer Station on West Third Street, Williamsport.

### \*\*\*Note: The by-laws of the PCPA needed to be amended.

We need to have a vote on the amendment change we made last fall. Notice to the members is to be made 30 days in advance in the Spring Newsletter, or by e-mail.

The State of Pennsylvania requires all non-profit organizations to include certain requirements in their bylaws. To retain our tax-exempt certification, the PCPA has added a clause in the Dissolution section to meet this requirement. The new addition reads:

#### **ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION**

**Section 1.** This Association shall not be dissolved by its own motion so long as seven members wish to continue it. In the event of sale or dissolution of the Association, the Association prohibits the use of any surplus funds for private inurement to any person. The Association surplus funds are to be donated to one or more non-profit organizations as deemed appropriate by the members.

The PCPA officers agree on this addition and feel it is appropriate.
