#### **Outdoor Club Outreach and Luncheon**

This club is advised by three teachers who seek to instill in these young people the values of preserving the environment and working to keep the resources available for all to enjoy.





On April 20, the group traveled to Little Pine State Park to help the staff prepare the park for the

summer season. Some picked litter across the dam and did trail maintenance on the far side of the lake while others stocked trout with the Fish Commission. Prior to this trip (knowing they would be helping to stock trout), members of the club constructed "floats for trout" to disperse the trout into the stream. The Outdoor Club has won awards for their activities from DCNR in Harrisburg.

After work, the group reassembled at 1 pm for a lunch hosted by PCPA who provided hot dogs with the fixins', clementine oranges and apples, cookies and other treats baked by PCPA members, bottled water and Lemonade for drinks.
