Peaceful Ponderings...

July 2025

When I began writing Peaceful Ponderings last week, Israel was bombing Iran and vice versa. There were questions about whether or not the US would get involved. My choice was to ignore what was happening, and write about the lectionary and shifting to the Old Testament continuous lessons for the season of Pentecost. There is much to learn from Old Testament stories.

And then, Sunday morning, I woke up to the news that the US had bombed nuclear storage sites in Iran. Israel and Iran are trading missiles. And, of course, Iran is threatening the US. Our governmental leaders are in conflict: some applauding the bombing, others questioning its constitutionality, and still others criticizing the actions and pointing to unknown yet potentially dangerous consequences.

President Trump, this afternoon (Monday) announced that a cease-fire agreement had been reached.

Some folks are scared, assuming this is the beginning of World War III. Others believe nothing will change and fear is not needed. To be honest, I don't think there is any way to know what is happening, and what will happen in the future.

This is what I'm thinking right now:

1. My call is to stay connected to our God, who is, bottom line, on the side of life for all of creation.
2. My call is to participate in God's project of promoting life.
3. Getting caught up in fear and anxiety about potential threats is not life giving for me, or for others.
4. Pretending that there is no threat is not particularly helpful either.
5. I will be intentional about: praying for peace; calmly listening to those with whom I disagree and offering my thinking; spending more time writing than watching cable news.

The world is an anxious place right now. Those Old Testament stories we will consider this summer remind us that even when we turn from God, God does not desert us, but continues to offer possibilities that are life-giving. Don't forget: our God is the one who brings life out of death.
