

The meeting was called to order at 10:22 a.m. by President M. Hart

Opening Prayer: Led by R. Knapton

Additions to Agenda: Setting budgeting schedule, insurance increase under treasurer's report. Continuing water in baptismal font under new business.

Approval of agenda: Motion by R. Knapton, seconded by C. Monsen to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried

Pastor's Report: None

Secretary's Report (Bev Stobber) Motion by C. Monsen seconded by E. Sherry to accept the council minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report (Sean McGinty) Deposits for the month of September were \$6285.00 Expenses were \$5613.61. The net balance for the month is \$671.39. Motion by C. Monsen, seconded by J. Monsen to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. Budget requests are due for November for 2025 budget determination. Janet McGinty will coordinate stewardship drive. Insurance costs for Peace have increased to \$837.32, an increase of approximately 14%. November 17, 2024, was set for a congregational meeting to approve the 2025 Operational budget.

Nurturing the Faith – Worship (Elaine Sherry): The Sunday service will be simplified for the present time while we have supply pastors. The date, including the year, will be added to the bulletin. The inclusion of more hymns from the Worship & Praise hymnal will be added to the service. Reformation Sunday is October 27th. All encouraged to wear red. All Saints Sunday, November 3rd, will have a table of candles and a table of loved ones' photos. Peace Church's anniversary will be celebrated November 17th, there will be a pot-luck brunch following the service and congregational meeting. Advent begins December 1st. We will have the Advent wreath and readings which will be read by the person who is that Sunday's scheduled reader. John Monsen will check out the outdoor Advent candles and if they are usable, they will be set up by Nov. 30th, if not, they will be omitted. A "Advent by Candite" program is planned for Sunday afternoon December 1st, 1:00 -3:00 pm. A sign-up sheet will be posted. Decorating the church for Christmas will be on Saturday December 7th beginning at 9 am. On December 22nd there will be a Cantata service along will communion. The tentative time for our Christmas Eve service will be 12:00 Noon. Poinsettias will be ordered from Berkot's. A sign-up sheet will be posted. Future pulpit supply was discussed. A concern regarding altar candles was discussed.
