



Preparing your dog for a board and train program involves careful planning and packing. This checklist will help you ensure that you provide all necessary items and information to the training facility. Please review each item and confirm that you have gathered everything needed for your dog's stay.

Essential Documents and Information

- **Vaccination Records:** Provide up-to-date vaccination records, including rabies, DHLPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, and Parvovirus), and Bordetella (kennel cough).
- **Emergency Contact Information:** Supply at least two emergency contacts, including names, phone numbers, and addresses, in case you are unreachable.
- **Veterinarian Information:** Include the name, phone number, and address of your primary veterinarian.

Personal Items

- **Food:** Provide an adequate supply of your dog's regular food to last the entire duration of the program. This helps maintain dietary consistency and avoids digestive upset. Please provide specific feeding instructions.
- **Medications:** If your dog requires any medications, provide them in their original containers with clear instructions regarding dosage and administration.
- **Bedding:** Include a familiar bed or blanket to help your dog feel more comfortable and secure in the new environment. Items should be machine washable.
- **Favorite Toys:** Pack a few favorite toys to provide comfort and reduce stress during the initial adjustment period. Limit the number to two or three to avoid overwhelming your dog.
- **Treats:** Supply a limited amount of your dog's favorite treats.

Important Instructions

- **Feeding Schedule:** Clearly outline your dog's regular feeding schedule, including the amount of food given at each meal.

- **Medical Conditions:** Inform the training facility of any pre-existing medical conditions your dog has, such as arthritis, diabetes, or heart conditions.
