"I am praying for them..."

Today's gospel reading, is a prayer, which appears at the end of Jesus' Last supper discourse. After that is arrested in the garden. The prayer might be read as Jesus' final commendation of himself to the Father. In the prayer, Jesus also expresses care and concern for his disciples.

In this prayer, Jesus reaffirms the complete union between him and the Father. Throughout the gospel of John, Jesus has been presented as the word, who was with from the beginning of creation and was sent to do the Father's work on earth. In this prayer we learn that Jesus' life and ministry have been directed toward revealing the Father. When the work is accomplished, Jesus must return to the Father to be glorified.

In today's gospel passage we also note the distinction found in John's gospel between the world and the disciples. The disciples are in the world, but they are separate from the world because they have been given to Jesus. They are chosen from the world to be in service to the world for its salvation. This salvation has been accomplished in Jesus because Jesus has revealed the Father to the world, but the disciples will be sent by Jesus to make both the Father and Jesus known to the world. Jesus' prayer is for the disciples' work in the world. The disciples have a mission to do, to preach the Goodnews to the end of the earth.

We are the disciples and our mission is to continue the work of Jesus. To proclaim the Goodnews to the end of the earth. Jesus is praying for us to do his work.
