

## Leslie Alexander Memorial Scholarship

Thank you for applying for the Leslie Alexander Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is designed for individuals who have actively participated in the agriculture/cattle industry and are committed to continuing their contributions to these industries, just as Leslie did.

The number of scholarship recipients and the dollar amount awarded shall be determined each year by the scholarship selection committee.

### Eligibility

This scholarship is available to any graduating or graduated high school student (applicants must be **21 years of age or younger as of January 1** of the application year) who has shown cattle at the Sagebrush Classic and/or have purchased/have parents that have purchased cattle from Hang'n A Cattle Company.

### Required Documentation

An application is considered "complete" only if it is accompanied by the following documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. A completed and signed Leslie Alexander Memorial Scholarship Application (Pages 2&3).
2. Each applicant must submit two letters of recommendation. Letters should be written on organization letterhead, signed, dated, and address the following areas:
  - References relationship to applicant and the length of time acquainted with applicant.
  - Applicants' goals for their chosen career path.
  - Applicants' leadership skills/activities within an agricultural group (example: FFA, 4H, Livestock Associations, Farm Bureau, Grange, etc.)
  - Applicants' reliability, dependability, willingness and honesty.
3. Unofficial transcript from current high school/college.
4. Copy of acceptance letter or class schedule from trade school or college you will be attending/are attending.
