 - Applicants' leadership skills/activities within an agricultural group (example: FFA, 4H, Livestock Associations, Farm Bureau, Grange, etc.)
 - Applicants' reliability, dependability, willingness and honesty.
- 3. Unofficial transcript from current high school/college.
- Copy of acceptance letter or class schedule from trade school or college you will be attending/are attending.
