Pool Hours are 10:00AM-10:00PM in suitable weather

Maximum Bathing load is 50 persons.

In an Emergency Dial 911-Telephone is located in red box by entrance to pool bathrooms.

Swimming Pool Rules:

The swimming pool is private property. If asked to leave pool area due to violation of rules or capacity limits please do so. If you choose not to leave after being asked you will be considered trespassing and the police will be called.

Use is strictly limited to residents and their authorized guests. Guests must be signed in at the office and obtain a guest pass. Only 2 guests per resident/homeowner during weekdays and 1 guest on weekends. All guests must be accompanied by a resident/homeowner with valid pass. **All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent or responsible adult.** Non-Swimmers of any age must be accompanied by an adult that can swim at all times.

Minors under age 12 are not required to have a pass with a limit of 2 non-dependent minors per authorized adult. Failure to comply with this will result in ejection from pool.

Pool passes must be worn or visible at all times.

Lounge chairs are on a first come first serve basis. **Please remain with your belongings at all times. If your belongings are found on a chair and you are not in the pool area, they will be removed by management.** There is not reserving chairs for any reason period.

The Following are **NOT** Permitted at any time:

1. Any person with an infection, open blister, cut, sore or contagious disease.
2. Babies in diapers or non-toilet trained children allowed inside pool.
3. Running, rough Play, jumping, excessive noise or foul language.
4. Diving into the pool.
5. Glass objects, containers or food in the pool enclosure.
6. Consumption of alcoholic beverages or smoking.
7. Pets in the pool enclosure
8. Improper swimwear, such as cut-off jeans, t-shirts, thong bathing suits etc.
9. Rafts or any inflatable toys
10. Vandalism of anything on the property including the bathrooms
11. Use of pool while under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, drugs or medicines (such use may lead to serious health consequences)

Management reserves the right to refuse admittance to, or eject from the pool premises, any person failing to comply with any of the above regulations.
