



2026 Stateline Karts Rules

Driver Apparel

- **Helmet should be SA2020 Snell (or newer) or DOT approved with full face shield. Helmets are subject to random safety inspections. Snowmobile or modular helmets are not permitted.**
 - SA2015 rated helmets will be acceptable for 2026 ONLY, if in approved condition. For Race Season 2027 helmet must be SA2020 or SA2025. SA2015 will not be permitted.
- **Full coverage driver wear including sturdy shoes, shocks over the ankle, racing jacket with long pants or a racing suit, and gloves. NO HOODIES. NO SWEATPANTS OR LEGGINGS. NO HEY DUDES OR SLIP ON SHOES.**
- **Neck Brace designed for racing is required.**
- **Racing gloves are always required while driving on the race track.**
- **Chest & Rib protection is recommended for all junior racers. Chest & Rib protection is MANDATORY for Squirts & Red Rookie.**
- **Long hair must be well secured and kept under the helmet. If hair is visible to track crew or scorer(s) while on racing surface, you may be asked to exit the racing surface for the remainder of the race for your own safety.**
- **No loose clothing while racing.**

Racers Rules & Conduct

- **All racers must sign a Waiver & Release of Liability. All minors must have a signed waiver by their parent/guardian, or they will not be permitted in the pit area.**
- **Race Age is determined as of January of that race year. You may be asked to provide proof of age with a birth certificate.**
- **ALL karts must have their race number CLEARLY displayed on both the RIGHT & LEFT SIDE, along with the rear of the kart. Numbers are to be NO LESS than 6 inches in height and in a contrasting color to your body for visibility.**
- **A pit pass must be worn on the wrist and visible at all times.**
- **Raceceivers are MANDATORY. No Excuses. All Classes except Squirts.**
- **Anyone called for rough driving will be sent to the pits.**
 - **Two offenses in the same day MAY result in the loss of points for that race. Calls made by the race director &/or flag stand are OFFICIAL.**
- **Verbal &/or Physical altercations can and will result in time off.**
- **NO karts are permitted to be driven in/through the pits.**
- **If a chain pops off, it can be fixed one time & kart goes to tail. If chain pops off a 2nd time, you will be sent to the pits.**
- **No additional kart maintenance/repair is permitted on the track.**
- **Classes may be combined in the event of low kart counts.**

- **All line ups will be posted on the line up board in the pit area. The driver is responsible for making it to the line up in time for their race.**
- **Track tech inspectors have binding and final say on all tech questions.**
- **NO alcohol consumption during the race program.**
- **In the event a race is canceled, it is considered complete if all heats plus one feature has been run. Management will make every attempt to reschedule remaining features within the next two weeks if possible. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**
- **Officials decisions will always be final. Management reserves the right to deny entry &/or remove any individual without further notice.**

Fan Conduct

- **Verbal abuse to any official, employee or volunteer is subject to removal off the premises.**
- **Verbal abuse to another racer can result in your removal from the grounds and possible future ban.**
- **Always conduct yourself in the spirit of good racing & sportsmanship.**
- **Please keep any pets on a leash.**
- **Please place all trash (including cigarette butts) into the proper receptacles.**
- **Management reserves the right to deny or remove any individual without further notice.**
