2026 VOTER GUIDE – FEDERAL SURVEY

CANDIDATES WERE ASKED IF THEY SUPPORT OR OPPOSE:

1. H.R. 21 – Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act (2025). Requires that the same medical care be provided to an infant born alive after surviving an attempted abortion as would be provided to any other premature baby at that gestational age.
 2. S. 9 – Protection of Women and Girls in Sports Act of 2025. Prevents biological males from competing against biological females in athletic competition under Title IX of the Education Amendments.
 3. H.R. 5 – Parents Bill of Rights Act (2023). Ensures that the rights of parents are honored and protected in the Nation's public schools.
 4. S. 3011 – Prohibiting Abortion and Transgender Procedures on the Exchanges Act (2025). Amends the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to exclude coverage of gender-transition procedures for minors and abortion under health plans offered through the American Health Benefits Exchanges.
 5. S. 382 – Dismantle DEI Act of 2025. Ensures equal protection of the law, prevents racism in the Federal Government, and prohibits diversity, equity, or inclusion practices.
 6. S. 2736 – In God We Trust Act (2025). Requires the Administrator of General Services to display or inscribe the national motto of the United States on all Federal buildings.
 7. S. 977 – End Taxpayer Funding of Gender Experimentation Act of 2025. Prohibits taxpayer-funded gender transition procedures.
 8. S. 1756 – Conscience Protection Act of 2025. Amends the Public Health Services Act to prohibit discrimination against health care entities that do not participate in abortion and strengthens implementation and enforcement of Federal conscience laws.
 9. H.R. 4964 – Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act (2025). Makes it an offense to transport a minor across state lines to evade parental notice or consent requirements.

1. Are you against legislation that would legalize assisted suicide (2025 - SB 1950 house amendment #2 or HB 1328)?
 2. Are you against legislation that would allow minors to make medical decisions without their parents' knowledge or consent? (HB 370-2021)
 3. Are you against legislation registering homeschooling families? (2025 - HB 2827)
 4. Are you against legislation requiring that public schools and public building restrooms designated as male-only install menstrual hygiene products in them? (HB 156-2021 / HB 2783-2025)
 5. Are you against legislation that would pay for abortions under Family Planning Services for women who are in this country illegally? (2025 - HB 3279 / SB 1846)
 6. Are you against legislation that would infringe on the free speech of pro-life women's resource centers and pro-life sidewalk counselors to talk to women about abortion harms? (SB 1909-2023)
 7. Are you against legislation that amends the Illinois Human Rights Act to make it a violation of the Act for an employer to "discriminate" against a person making a "reproductive health decision" affecting the use or intended use of health care, goods, or services related to reproductive processes, functions and systems, including family planning, pregnancy testing, contraception, fertility or sterilization care, or termination of pregnancy? NOTE: This would force pro-life non-profits to hire pro-abortion persons, which would be against their "right of association?" (HB 4867-2024)
 8. Are you against legislation that would decriminalize or legalize prostitution? (HB 3518, HB 3626, and SB 2391-2025)
 9. Are you against legislation mandating vaccines for children whose parents want a religious exemption to this? (SB 3668-2020)
