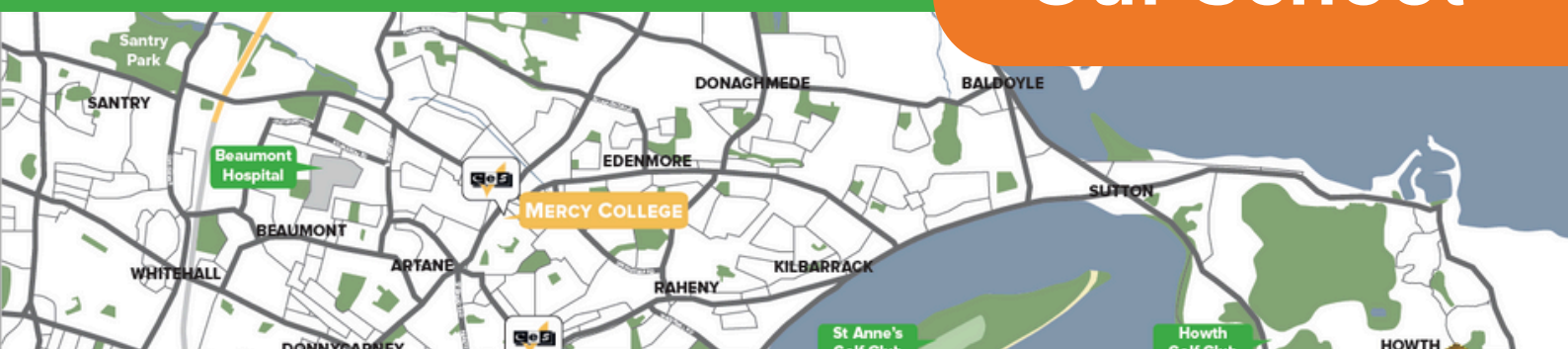


Dublin has more green spaces per square kilometer than any other European capital city. Dublin is known for its abundance of parks and open areas.





# Our School



## Junior Summer Centres in Dublin: Mercy College

Our school is located to the north of Dublin city, between 3-5km from the city centre. The centre is located close to major public transport links so it is easy to move to and from your homestay to the school and from the school to the city centre. The centre has a dedicated, individual management team of a Principal, a Director of Studies and a Social Co-Ordinator. Our centre is an Irish State secondary schools during the academic year so have excellent classroom and sports facilities as well as large grass-covered open spaces. CES has been running this centre for over 30 years, and we maintain a network of excellent homestays in the surrounding areas. Travel time from the airport is 25 minutes.



**Also included:** Gymnasium, full size grass football, rugby and five-a-side football pitches. Table tennis rooms. Computer access for leaders.

## RUGBY PROGRAMME

CES and the I.R.I (Irish Rugby Institute) have successfully run our rugby programme for more than 10 years. Ireland has become one of the top rugby-playing countries in the world with the national and provincial sides doing very well internationally. Our 2-week programme caters for all levels of rugby players where the focus of the programme is on skill development (passing/kicking/tackling), nutrition for rugby knowledge, tactics and above all, fun! Male and female students from all over the globe have come together on this programme to improve themselves as rugby players in a superb international environment.

# Junior Homestay Accommodation

## The Homestay Experience



- Full board homestay accommodation .
- Rooms: Shared bedrooms.
- Meals: Breakfast (includes fruit juice, cereal, toast, jam and fruit), packed lunch (sandwich, fruit, yoghurt, crisps and a drink) and dinner (meat, poultry or fish and fresh vegetables) included in the package.
- Travel time: 25 minutes by walking/public transportation.
- Laundry: Light laundry usually once a week.
- Curfew times:  
14 and 15 year olds @ 21.00hrs,  
16 and 17 year olds @ 22.00hrs.  
All students are to return home by 18:00 for dinner (unless the school-scheduled evening event)
