Young Learners learn best when they have the best facilities, which is why we are proud to partner with **Worthing's largest Further Education College** for our summer centre.

The College is a **modern campus** with state-of-the-art facilities. There are 40 multimedia classrooms, a theatre, and a dance studio.

The campus has a Students' Union and two large exhibition spaces, all of which we use for learning and activities.

The large **student canteen** and **shop** offer drinks and snacks with both indoor and outdoor seating.

The College also has acres of **green spaces** we use to relax and socialise and sports facilities for football, as well as tennis and basketball courts.

Public buses are a short walk to the South of the Campus allowing easy access to the centre of Worthing town and to the railway station which we use for many of our trips.

The School Day



The CES Young Learner timetable has been designed to allow students to maximise their time with CES.

Each week students receive:

- 15 hours of tuition in morning and afternoon sessions
- Five activities including one evening activity, one half day and one full-day excursions

During the peak weeks in July and August our Centre offers a “Zig Zag” timetable with 3 class sessions in the morning and 2 in the afternoon on Programme A, and 2 class sessions in the morning and 3 in the afternoon on Programme B. Activities and Trips then complete the programme. Half Day excursions are always in the afternoons.



Trips and Activities



Our programme of activities and excursions balances cultural visits, fun and games and personal and social development:

Each week students receive:

- Four day-time activities
- An evening Disco or Party (with Shuttle Bus)
- One Half day Excursion
- One Full day Excursion (Saturdays)
- Optional additional excursions and activities are also available

All activities are led by our famous Yellow Shirt activity team!



Full-Day Excursions: London Classic, Portsmouth, and Oxford including a College visit, London Museums and Galleries,

Half-Day Excursions: Arundel Castle, Brighton and its Royal Pavilion, Chichester and its Cathedral

Our College and local activities are themed: Worthing activities, Sports and Games, Personal and Social Development, Going Out and About.

The programme includes a diverse range of traditional activities such as sports but also team building activities, Conversation Clubs as well as Talent shows and the CES Olympics!

Homestay in Worthing



Total language immersion with selected and inspected local families.

Rooms Single rooms (individual students) or shared rooms (group students)

Food Breakfast (includes fruit juice, cereal, toast, jam and fruit)

Packed lunch (sandwich, fruit, yoghurt, crisps and a drink) and **dinner** (meat, poultry or fish and fresh vegetables) included in the package

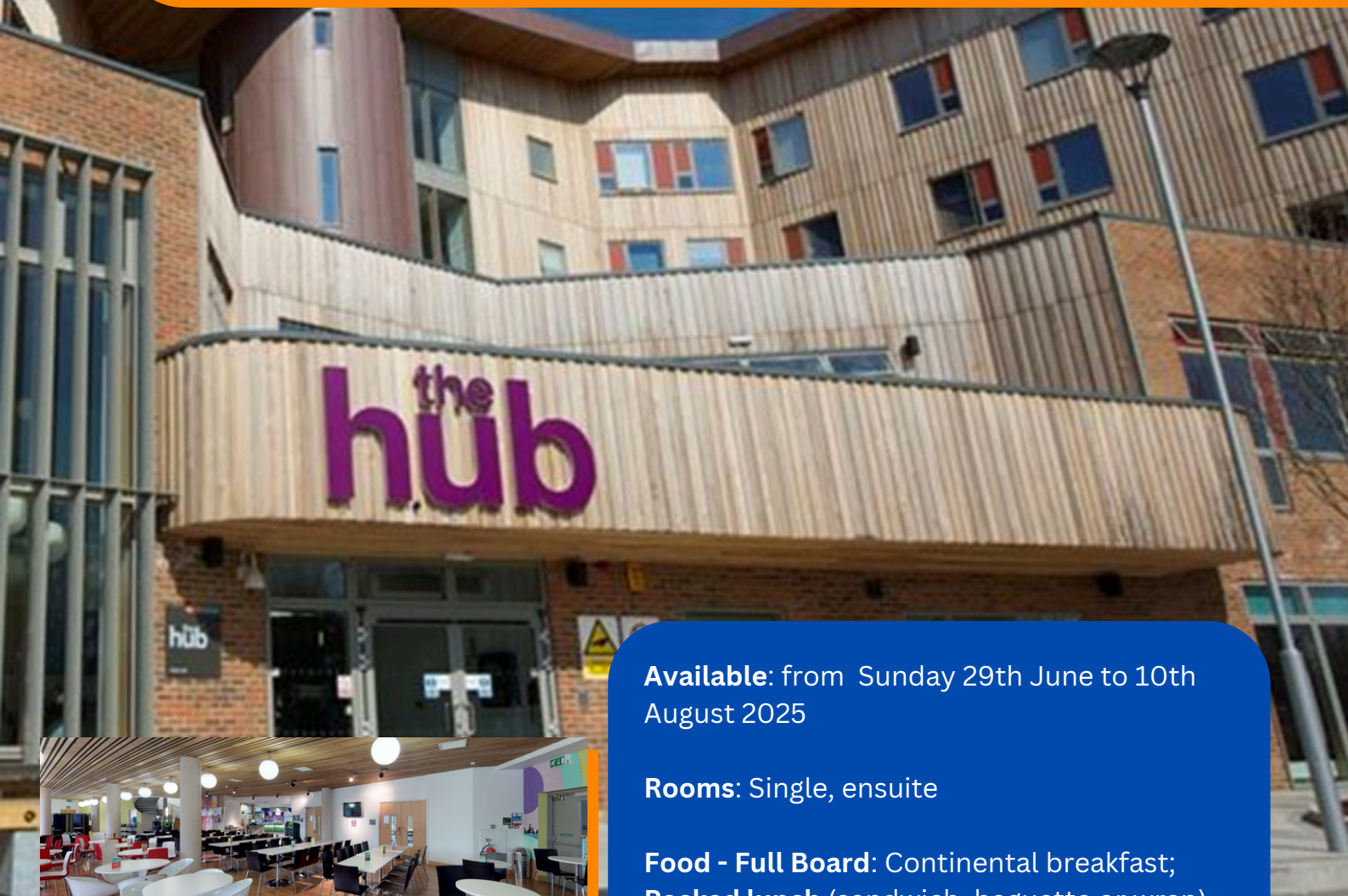
Travel many hosts are within 30 minutes' walk or a bus ride of the College (tickets included) and a shuttle bus is organised to and from our disco activity.
