

Kansas State University Urban Food Systems Initiative Student Award

During the biennial Urban Food Systems Symposium, two student awards will be given:

1. One award for the best oral presentation given by a student who is at the same time the presenter and first author of the submitted abstract
2. One award for the best poster presented by a student who is the first author of the work

A special committee, set up by the chairs of the organizing committee and scientific committee, will be responsible for selecting the awardees. Students to be eligible for this award must be the lead and presenting author of the submission and should be enrolled in a university or college as an undergraduate, graduate, or postgraduate (limited to 6 months after finishing the program of study), and with an age limit of 35.

How to participate? To indicate your interest in the Student Award, check the appropriate choice during the submission of your abstract. By indicating your interest in the Student Award, you confirm that you meet the above-mentioned criteria for participation and agree to accept the terms and conditions.

Kansas State University Urban Food Systems Initiative Student Award winners will be recognized in the final symposium program book that is published as part of the online proceedings, including a photo of the award ceremony or the award winners and a brief outline of the winners. Awardees will be invited to write a summary of their research, to be considered for publication in the UFSS Proceedings. A certificate will be awarded to the winners.
