Additional Hospital Information & Instruction

It is recommended to have 2 adults accompany your child to and from the hospital. One adult should remain next to the child during the drive home to ensure neck (airway) is upright and observe for vomiting.

Once your child is home, start introducing clear liquids and light foods. Make sure your child remains hydrated. Activity should be limited for 24 hours following general anesthesia, to prevent dizziness or injury.

Your child may experience a sore throat or nose from the placement of the intubation tube with the general anesthesia.

If your child experiences any discomfort or slight fever, you can give them Children's Tylenol as directed. For temperatures over 101F, call Dr. Kierstin Kerr.

If your child experiences severe vomiting or bleeding, go directly to the emergency room and please notify Dr. Kierstin Kerr.
