Painted dogs? Zebra? Lions?!

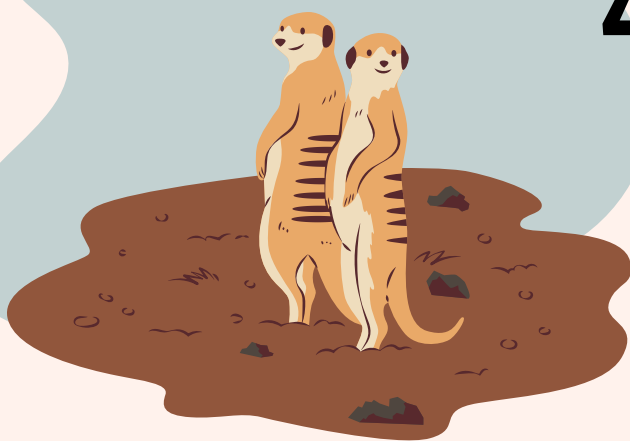
