


Figure 2: Brown as Det. Debree in "The Laramie Project"

Brown is a director successful with all kinds of theatre but is exceptional with Comedy and Musical Theatre. He believes a story should be both seen and heard, not only told emotionally, but when done correctly, the audience will experience the muscular expression of the story. Brown is passionate about bringing his unique vision to the timeless themes of personal conflict and the human experiences. Some of his previous directorial experiences include Eurydice with Wildcat Theatre Company, Oklahoma! with Lon Morris College, Southern Hospitality with Wildcat Theatre Company, Amahl and The Night Visitors with C. U. Methodist Playhouse, and *The Fantasticks* with Lon Morris College.

H. Russ Brown is has been choreographing fights on stage for 25 years in over 100 productions as a Certified Teacher with the Society of American Fight Directors. He has worked all over the country, from Chicago, to Houston, to L.A. to New York, and back. Brown believes that staged violence should serve the story, not show off his choreography. He works collaboratively with the production team to design the choreography, ensure the Director's vision is honored, and create safe and dramatically effective moves. Some of his previous work as an SAFD Certified Teacher includes *The Three Musketeers* with Alley Theatre, *Hamlet* with Trama Theatre Company of Chicago, Newsies with Stratford HS Players, Sweeney Todd with Columbia Entertainment Company, I Hate Hamlet with Nicolet College, and Julius Caesar with UW-Stevens Point. Brown also has choreography experience with weapons, unarmed / martial arts,

and equestrian skills. The weapons Brown has experience with are Broadsword, Bullwhip, Small Sword, Western Lariat, Single Sword, Knife, Rapier / Dagger, Quarterstaff / Bo Staff, Shaolin Spear, Filipino Fighting Sticks, Sword & Shield, and Firearms. The unarmed / martial arts experience is with Tae Chuang Do, Tae Kwon Do, Kickboxing, Boxing, Wrestling, and Street / Ground Fighting. The Equestrian Skills he has experience with is Western / Rodeo.
