## Our **SUPER**Week

We wrapped up our unit on *Winter* this week with our class performance of *The Mitten!* The children did a wonderful job, and our younger audience loved it!

## Here are a few highlights from our week:

- We counted and graphed vowels in our first and last names, color words, and numbers. In their math journals, the children wrote words and counted their vowels. Afterwards, they wrote the number of vowels next to each word. This was a helpful way to practice writing numbers! We also used the information from our Math journals to make a graph of how many vowels are in our full names. This was a great way to work on writing our last names, as well as being able to look at data in more than one way; we could write our own results in our journals or compare our results with the rest of the class on a graph.

- We finished our author study of Jan Brett. We read *The Three Snow Bears* and quickly found similarities between it and the other Jan Brett stories we have read this month. The story also reminded us of a classic tale: *Goldilocks!* We love being able to compare familiar stories and their characters. At the end of the week, we discussed which Jan Brett books were our favorites, and which characters we enjoyed the most. The children did a great job recalling important details in each story. We also discussed Jan Brett's writing and illustrating style, and how it is different from many of the other books we read in our classroom. Jan Brett has quickly become a classroom favorite!
