Color Mania

We wrapped up our "color mania" theme by creating our "I See a Rainbow" book! The children have been working hard to create a page for each color of the rainbow. On each page they wrote the color, glued on construction paper and added stickers that match the color. Our show and share this month was a little different. With all the items brought in we were able to build a nature rainbow together. The children enjoyed sharing what they were able to find. We noticed green was the most common item to find in nature, while blue was the hardest.
