We started our "color mania" theme by exploring the zany world of Dr. Seuss. We discussed how Dr. Seuss is an author and we celebrate him in March. As we read and discussed his books, we discovered he uses many rhyming and opposite words. The kids had fun coming up with a list of their own rhyming words.

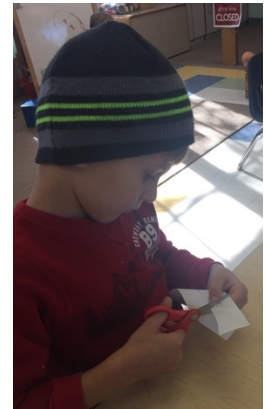
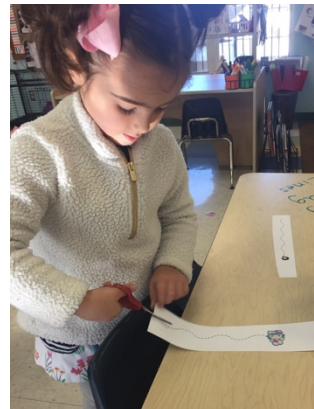
We first read *My Many Colored Days*. In this book Dr. Seuss uses colors and illustrations to describe various emotions. As a class we came up with a list of colors and how these colors can sometimes make us feel. We also discussed how it is ok to have these feelings, and sometimes we may even feel more than one feeling at a time. We then asked the children to draw a self-portrait of the color they were feeling that day.

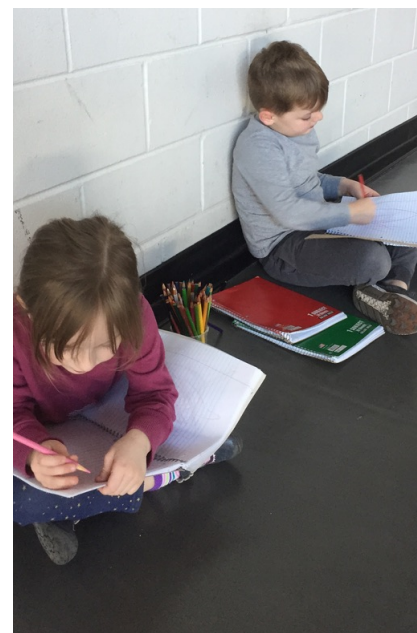
