**Please note:**

You will not be registered until we have received **ALL** the following items:

- Completed and signed Registration Form
- Registration fee via money order, made payable to **"Yonkers Hispanic Cultural Foundation Inc."**
- Historical data regarding your group on the Registration Form (so we can accurately introduce your organization from the Grand Stand)
- Copies of the valid /active vehicle registration, insurance card. Vehicle must be driven by a person with a valid Driver license.

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### Parade Rules and Regulations

1. All organizations participating in the Yonkers Puerto Rican / Hispanic Day Parade must submit a completed application and in the event of an emergency must have. A list with them of their participants.
2. No more than 100 people per group. School and folkloric groups have no limit.
3. All participants must promote Hispanic heritage, culture and pride with dignity and respect.
4. All participants, vehicles and or floats must reflect a respect for general public decency and moral values, including a dress code of a professional or cultural nature.
5. Participants cannot use profane or offensive language, symbols or gestures.
6. The use of any flag to decorate a float must be done in a respectable and dignified manner.
7. *Non-traditional Flags with symbols will not be allowed.*
8. No political or electoral advertisement or signs may be displayed by any contingent.
9. **NO THIRD-PARTIES** will be allowed to march with Original group that signed on the Application. Every organization / Group must complete an application of their own so you can be assigned a line up position for the parade.
10. All participants must adhere to the instructions of Parade Coordinators during the parade.

**PARADE FLOATS:** If you are interested in a float, please contact us for information.

We will get back to you with further details. The design process and costs will be negotiated directly between your group and the float vendor we put you in contact with.

- Float design and marching contingents must be described at time of application.
- Any group, vehicle or float deemed inappropriate will not be allowed to participate.
- Participants with floats from an outside source must provide a copy of Float Insurance.

#### **Motor vehicles:**

1. No unregistered or un-insured motor vehicles allowed.
2. **No** 18 wheelers will be allowed.
3. For security reasons, closed vehicles will be used to pull the floats only.
4. Each group is limited to 5 vehicles at the parade, unless otherwise authorized.
5. For security reasons all vehicles are subject to search.
6. **All Vehicles must submit a copy of valid insurance certificate, vehicle registration and driver's license.**
