Expandable Home Installation Instructions

Ground Preparation

The foundation of the house must be solid, level and clean. Ideally concrete surface or concrete footings.

Step 1 – Place the unit

Position the unit onto the foundations. The unit is equipped with two rear roller wheels designed for easy loading and unloading during transport.

Utilize the bottle jack to elevate the unit, allowing for the removal of the roller wheels and installation of the included adjustable legs. Ensure the adjustable legs are securely attached.

Verify the unit's levels and make necessary adjustments by turning the adjustable legs as needed.

Step 2 – Waterproof part A – Before opening the unit

Apply the expanding foam into the crevices adjacent to the hinges on both the upper and lower sections of the unit. Install the rubber sealant along the closing edges of the expandable portions.

Step 3 – Open the roof panel

Loosen the nuts securing the locks on the roof panel and move the roof panel away from the unit. Use a 2.7m supporting log to keep the roof panel elevated.



Step 4 – Lower the floor

Secure the hand winch at each end, in the spots where the locks were previously situated. Thread the cable through the provided roller to the designated hooking point on the floor panel. Before attempting to lower the unit, it is crucial to acquaint yourself and all involved parties with the operation of the winch, including understanding the locking and unlocking mechanisms.



After ensuring that the cable is securely hooked and ready, release the locks on the floor panel. Give a gentle push from inside the unit to set the movement in motion. Lower the floor slowly and steadily using the hand winch.



Step 5 – Attach the legs and use filler along the edges

Before lowering the unit completely to the floor, attach the adjustable legs. Additionally, before opening the side panel, apply expanding foam in the crevices and filler along the edges.

Step 6 – Lift the side panels

Elevate the side panel into position with the assistance of 2 to 3 individuals needed to lift and securely lock it in place with the roof panel. Swing open the front panels into position and slide the corners into place. Verify levels and make adjustments to the legs as necessary.

For a two-bedroom unit, install the room partition panel in its designated position.

Follow steps 3,4,5 and 6 for the other side. Check levels for the whole unit

Step 7 – Secure the side and front panels.

Utilize the supplied angle brackets and screws to firmly fasten the panels together at both the top and bottom corners.

Step 8 – Fit the kitchen.

Fit the kitchen in place and connect the hardware.

Step 9 – Waterproof

First, apply the waterproof sealant, and then follow up by affixing the 3M weather protection tape along the edges of the expandable sections.

To lock the unit, left the handle up and turn the key. The unit have a three-point locking mechanism.
