<b>Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus</b> <i>Apostolado ng Panalangin enthrones the image/picture of Sacred Heart to the requesting family</i>	Whole year
<b>Fatima Block Rosary</b> <i>The Fatima Association brings the image of Our Lady of Fatima to families for the praying of the Holy Rosary</i>	Whole year
<b>Divine Mercy Devotion</b> <i>The Divine Mercy Home Evangelization Program brings the Divine Mercy image to families for eight days. Later, the group enthrones the Divine Mercy Image to the requesting family</i>	Whole year
<b>2,000 Hail Mary</b> <i>Marian Devotees gather to pray 2,000 Hail Mary with a host family</i>	Whole year
<b>Vigil to the Blessed Sacrament</b> <i>Members of different religious organizations take turn in staying with the Lord every first Friday from 5:00 pm to 12:00 midnight</i>	First Friday
<b>Penitential Procession</b> <i>Following the request of Our Lady of Fatima for reparation, the dawn penitential procession is held every first Saturday at 4:30 in the morning. After the procession, vigil before the exposed Blessed Sacrament is held with reflections on the message of Our Lady of Fatima</i>	First Saturday
<b>Bagong Buwan</b> <i>The practice of carrying images of saints along the streets every first Sunday for people to kiss the image</i>	First Sunday
<b>Vivahan</b> <i>Children roam around to greet families with happy new year.</i>	New Year
<b>Harian</b> <i>The celebration of Harian started with "HULI-WHITE" in 1951 when a white rooster was suddenly seen while a group of friends was having a shindig. Astonished by what they had seen, they tried to capture the white bird. Thus the word "HULI" which means to capture. "WHITE" refers to the color of the bird. That same night, the group of friends proclaimed themselves as the three kings in honor of Kings Melchor, Gaspar and Baltazar and they called their kingdom as "HULI-WHITE"</i>	January
<b>Pinetensya</b> <i>Penitents express sorrow for their sins by flagellating themselves while processing around the town.</i>	Holy Week
<b>Via Crusis and Alay Pasan Krus</b> <i>Among the most popular procession in the parish is the Via Crusis. The Way of the Cross attracts a huge number of parishioners and it culminates with the Good Friday Alay Pasan Krus</i>	Five Sunday of Lent
<b>Pabasa ng Pasyong Mahal</b>	Holy Week
<b>Flores de Mayo</b> <i>Praying of Novena to the Blessed Virgin Mary every afternoon the whole month of May</i>	May
<b>Reyna Elena</b> <i>The Procession commemorates the finding of the holy cross in Jerusalem by St. Helena the Empress. Adding color to the procession is the inclusion of Biblical characters, Titles of the Virgin Mary and some historical figures.</i>	Last Sunday of May
<b>Santacruzán</b> <i>A synchronized novena in the three poblacion barangays which consists of bringing three antique crosses to the homes of nine families for overnight stay. It is also an occasion for feasting and gathering.</i>	9 Days before the Reyna Elena procession
<b>Dalaw Patron</b> <i>In preparation for the parish fiesta, the Pilgrim image of San Pedro Apostol visits all barangays of the parish. The visit is highlighted by a novena and vigil to the pilgrim image of St. Peter, adult catechesis, free baptism, procession and celebration of the Holy Mass.</i>	June
<b>Sunduan</b> <i>An old custom where young swains fetch young ladies. Coming from strategic places of the town, the participants converge in a central point and altogether paraded to the town kiosk for a short ceremony and program</i>	June
<b>San Luis</b> <i>It is celebrating devotion to San Luis by families which had roots from Quezon</i>	August
<b>San Roque</b> <i>After praying the novena for nine days in the parish church, the feast day of Barangay 3 is highlighted by a procession from the church going to the chapel of Barangay 3</i>	August
<b>Paglilibot ng Birhen ng Peñafrancia</b> <i>The devotion of bringing the image in the barangays.</i>	September
