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Before Time

It is by sin that we diminish our connection with the Holy Spirit, for He is Life, without which there would only be death.

The angels would be made in a spiritual form. Mankind will be made in the image and likeness of God, in the bodily form of Jesus and with a mind, heart and soul. This formation of mankind was the first spark of creation. God's first thought of all creation was Mary, the mother of Jesus. She was God's first thought because it would only be through her that the key to the success of all creation could occur, which is Jesus.

Mary was formed in the timeless moment within the eternal Love of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Without spiritual nor original sin. She would not ever touch the stains of sin that the rest of creation would be burdened by because of this unique moment of how she was created. Only a single creation of God's could be made in this way, both without the desire to sin and the fullness of freewill. That creation is Mary, made through and within perfection.

The location that Mary was created is also the Great Gift that God is preparing for those that reside with Him in Heaven.

The Father then turned His focus to creating the angels. They would be created before mankind.

The Father stepped forward from His throne in Heaven so that Jesus and the Holy Spirit would not be visible to what He would form in front of Him. As He looked out into His domain of Heaven, He first put limits on the extent of Heaven. Beyond this limit became a void, an emptiness unlike anything that had existed before. With the creation of the void was also something similar to time, but not quite the way we understand it in our physical reality. There is physical time that we understand, but there is also a spiritual time which works a bit differently.

The reason time was created before both angelic and human individuals were made is because it is essential to forgiveness. For love to occur, freewill is required. Freewill results in imperfections, otherwise known as sin. While time provides for growth, learning, and spiritual maturity, within freewill each creation also becomes fallible through bad decisions and mistakes. Because of this outcome, time is the means that makes repentance, and thus Forgiveness, actionable. As God is merciful, all of His creation in spirit form is called to His forgiveness three times.

Through St. Faustina we learned to call this Divine Mercy. Divine Mercy was also offered to the angels. Part of their Divine Mercy was seeing how their decisions and actions had hurt others. This was the pivotal point in their forgiveness because those that took joy in seeing the suffering of those they harmed would be banned from God for eternity. If a soul doesn't empathize with the suffering of others, they have chosen to reject Truth and Love. Many angels would fall this way.

At this point, all that would be visible to each angel once they are formed would be the Father before them and the seven steps up to Him. Below them would be a vast white floor, much commonly depicted as looking like a cloudlike substance. This floor would be the location where all the angels would be made.

When initially created, all were only to look at the Father. Any deviation from that during this initial moment of creation would be a grave sin. The angels that were created behind other angels would not be able to easily notice the angels in front of them because in their form and appearance, their backs, which were covered by what could be called a spiritual cloak, blended in with the floor of heaven. It was almost as if each were camouflaged. Additionally, the brilliance, beauty, and boldness of the Father far outshined the white appearance of the backs of the angels and the floor.

Now that God had prepared every aspect for the beginning of creation, He went to work.

Creation of Angels

The first angel God created was Lucifer.

It was in this singular moment that Lucifer was actually happy. Right after being made his first thought was that he and God were all there would, and ever, be. His assumption was the first act of freewill, and it was incorrect.

Lucifer thought that for eternity, just the two of them would be together. In thinking this, Lucifer began to almost put himself on the same level as the Father. In his pride, rather than loving the Father completely Lucifer became enamored with the misperception that he would have all the power he saw the Father to have.

While these were brief thoughts that popped into his head and enticed him, Lucifer was most satisfied that he and the Father would be the power together.

As God recognized the conflicting thoughts and misguided ideology that Lucifer was contemplating, all while trying to appear still fully committed to the Father, God continued to create. Michael was then formed to the right of Lucifer. Then Gabriel to Michael's right. This first row extended out until all the archangels were made. None of them knew they were next to another angel, except Lucifer began to sense there was more going on but wasn't quite sure what that was.

Because of the new spiritual time the Father had placed in motion, from the moment an angel was formed the Holy Spirit began to guide and train each of them. He quietly taught each individually about the gifts they were created to have, what would be their work in Heaven, and their relationship

with God and others. This was done so seamlessly that the angels did not yet comprehend the Holy Spirit.

Even though the angels didn't have a conceptual, tangible, or literal understanding of the Holy Spirit, they were still guided by His teachings. While the angels were being taught, the Father continued to create more angels in other groupings.

This moment of creation didn't just occur all at once and then was complete. It was brought about purposefully and with reason, in a natural spiritual manner by the Law derived from the Truth of the Father.

Each grouping of angels was created with special gifts and purposes. Within those groups every angel is provided individual gifts, which while they relate to the group, are personal to themselves. The archangels were created with a large amount of strength, but what was greater for them was their intellect and level of wisdom. Within that group Lucifer had the highest level of wit and knowledge, Michael was made with superior leadership qualities like a general, Gabriel was made to be the highest messenger, Raphael a healer, and so on. While they are all tied together through wisdom, they have unique areas that they each excel in as well. Every archangel also has qualities that others would want to embrace and follow, even though some are better known than others.

It was at this time that Lucifer started to become curious about why he was being taught certain lessons. He began to recognize that the teachings no longer seemed to be focused on himself and the Father alone. They appeared to be including something more. Lucifer was confounded by how he was being taught to interact with... all he could assume was himself? He couldn't comprehend what was truly being shared and revealed, which was how to love others. Lucifer felt there was no need for such ridiculousness because it was only himself and the Father.

It was in this moment that the first act of sin occurred. Lucifer realized that his perception of something next to him, along with these teachings, meant there was more going on than he realized and wanted. With that, Lucifer took the slightest peek to his right. In that act, he saw Michael. An instant rage coursed through his entire being. It wasn't just the Father and himself anymore, for some reason... there was another?!?

Because of Lucifer's first act of sin, the Father took two steps to protect all the angels. First, He called on all the archangels to look to their side so that they could see each other. All but one took great enjoyment in this moment. Once they had all briefly met, they returned their gaze to the Father.

Next, the Father created the Cherubim. The 5 guardians of the throne of God. (After all occurs, there are only 4 guardians because one falls.) They were created upon the level that the Father was at, but were situated in such a way that they were not visible to, nor able to see, the archangels. They were created with four different faces that together could see in all directions. This was required because they always need to be both looking at the Father, as well as seeing out away from the Father to recognize any dangers.

They were made at this time so that they would be ready when the chaos God was aware of, would come.

The most essential reason for the creation of the Cherubim at this time was that any contact with the Father would destroy the angel. They would no longer exist. The Father's Power is much too great for them and any contact would result in their eradication. Because of this, the Cherubim were there to stop any angel from touching the Father, which occurred mainly through deterrence because they had been created the strongest of all the angels. Even more powerful than the archangels.

The Father continued to create more angels. Even though He began with groups that had small numbers, now they would become more, many more. Thousands, then millions and on and on. All were created behind the location of the archangels. Countless numbers appeared in massive sections all only looking upon the Father.

As the rage in Lucifer grew, he decided to take an even larger look around. As he turned his head to look behind Michael, Lucifer began to see the massive number of angels behind them. Still convinced that he was made to be in charge with the Father, Lucifer began to take delight in this moment. Not only was he with the Father, but that together they would rule over all of these angels. Lucifer thirsted even more for such power and dominion, and it seemed that the Father had created an entire kingdom for him to rule over.

Taking such satisfaction and pride in thinking that the Father was doing all this for him, Lucifer calmed down and started to fantasize about his power over so many.

After the last angel was formed, the Father began to reveal all He had created to the entirety of angels. Just about all of them took great delight in seeing the vastness of the family God had just brought forth. All except Lucifer, who played along with a façade of joy, as he was waiting for himself to be announced as their ruler. While he was greedily excited, his pride festered with the thoughts that he was having. From his assumptions and imagination, he began to despise all the other angels.

The Father then calmed down all of creation because He had more to share with all of them.

Lucifer thought that this was his moment, where he would be announced as the first of, and ruler over, of all creation. But that would never happen.

To the right of the Father appeared a Man. He was physically smaller than all the angels. The Father looked upon Him, and then spoke boldly out to all the angels and announced with more Strength and Power than anything previously shared, "This is My Son."

A great roar of joy went up from the vast number of angels. In the middle of the celebrative cheers was a voice of hatred screeching in utter contempt and anger. Almost imperceptible because of how loud the cheers were from all of the angels, Lucifer screamed at his loudest with feelings of betrayal and treachery. He realized that all he had assumed and wanted was never going to occur. He looked upon the Son of God and saw his first enemy. He couldn't fathom how the Father, being so Strong and Powerful, could have a Son that appeared so vulnerable and frail. He couldn't understand how the Father would prefer such an apparent weak waste, to Lucifers power and genius.

Every horrible thought began to course through the intellect of Lucifer, and none were rejected. It was in this moment that Lucifer changed. He hated God, His Son, all the angels, and himself. In this moment he rejected his name and replaced it with Satan. While his exterior appearance remained as Lucifer, intellectually he had taken on the new moniker.

At that thought, Lucifer began his decent into madness as he started planning to destroy as much of what God created as he could. Even theorizing that if he brought enough angels together to follow him, the Father could be overthrown, and he could rule all of what God had created.

It was at the sight of Jesus, the fulfillment of God's Love, that evil arose.

The Seduction

After revealing Jesus, the Father informed the angels that He would be leaving them for a short time but would return. He warned them that unexpected problems would arise, but that they should hold on to their faith in Him and their love for each other. He also shared that He would always be with them.

With the message given, both the Father and Jesus turned and went behind their throne to a location where they were no longer visible to the angels. When the Father stated that He would always be with them, none of the angels realized that He was speaking of the Holy Spirit.

Lucifer could not believe this opportunity had just been placed before him. That the creator of all the angels left, thus allowing him to take over all of known creation. He composed himself as the plan of his domination slowly formed in his thoughts.

The rest of the angels slowly began to get to know each other. Since there were so many, it would take quite a bit of time for everyone to understand the way God had created them all. This communion would also provide more time for Lucifer to investigate the weaknesses and strengths of others so that he could exploit them.

Lucifer, being the first angel created, was the one that all the others wanted to meet. What they noticed, which brought them some confusion, was the unique appearance of Lucifer. Every other angel was pure and white and their robes were either white or just slightly tan. While Lucifer had a white robe, the parts of his spirit that were visible were a bit different. His began to have a slightly darker hue, and some blots started appearing in certain areas. His hands were also more elongated and came to more of a point than all the others.

None of the angels could figure out why there were these differences. They had small debates where some thought it was a virtue by being the first angel created. A few speculated that these additional features might be good things that were special, almost a sign of his significance to be their teacher and guide. While others were beginning to both internally, and at times publicly, questioned what was occurring within Lucifer that resulted in his appearance to be altered.

The changes were most noticeable to Michael, the Arc Angel that was created next to Lucifer. He was the first to see him not long after they were created. At that point Lucifer looked just as pure and brilliant as all the other Arc Angels. Now his appearance was different, and Michael was not impressed with what he saw. To him, any changes from the form the Father had made them needed to be questioned.

At this point, little did any of the angels realize that the differences they saw in Lucifer were because of his sin. The staining upon his soul was from his rejection of God. The hatred festering deep within him was becoming visible to all. Lucifer wasn't even quite sure what the results would be from these blotches and stains, but he embraced them as he thought that anything that took it away from what the Father had made him to be was a good thing.

He no longer wanted to appear as he was made, because everything from the Father disgusted him, even his own appearance. In his twisted view, Lucifer felt the Father had betrayed him, so he now viewed God as the traitor.

One thing Lucifer didn't expect or understand at first was that the stains and blotches from the sin were actual the visual weakening of his spirit. With each spiritual sin, the unknown life force to all the angels, the Holy Spirit, was being slowly separated from him. By the act of sin, the Holy Spirit was moving away from Lucifer, and thus his strength was diminishing.

Even though the angels were not aware of the Holy Spirit at this time, He is part of all creation, a very quiet part, as He is the life force to all living beings. For now, He was the unspoken Third Member of God which was provided to every angel at the point of their creation.

It was in the changing appearance of Lucifer that some of the angels began to garner interest. But there was one that was much more interested than all the others. That angel's name is Lilith, and she was also full of hatred, thirsty for power, and had become rather devious.

She was one of the physically weaker angels and her negative thoughts came about because of her smaller stature. She just didn't like the way she was formed, feeling like the Father had kind of made her the runt of the litter. Even though none of the other angels viewed her this way, it was from her own lack of self-awareness that she began to grow envious of others and desired power.

She is from a group of smaller angels whose qualities reside in their intuitive abilities and guidance. She could see things about others that were not visible as well as understand the essence of each angel just by looking at them. The gifts that they were given, when used properly, could help others to grow and mature. Because Lilith was full of envy, she began to use her gifts to harm and diminish others. Because she was so talented, she could break angels efficiently, without the receiver or others around even noticing that she was hampering their growth.

Lilith's rage came from her anger towards the Father for leaving. Above all else, she is drawn to power as she initially wished to be His bride. His leaving resulted in her primary option for dominion to now be Lucifer. She even began to feel more drawn to him than to her recollection of the Father. She is one that is obsessed with the present and can't see beyond her own wants. Ironically, the gift she was provided with to help others was not one she could utilize on herself.

It was when she saw and met Lucifer that she realized her opportunity. She now had a new path to rise to the heights that she aspired before the Father left. She realized that if they unite, they could become dominantly powerful. In seeing the darkness, hate and pride in his soul, she saw that he wanted the same as her, power. So, she went to seduce him with a plan of uniting their gifts to achieve complete control.

She pursued and enticed Lucifer, feeding his ego and building up his pride. From her beginning, Lilith always felt the need for a strong masculine source to tie herself to, and now that was Lucifer

While angels are not made as male or female physically, some carry qualities of love that humans generally recognize to be masculine, and others carry those that would be considered feminine. All love comes from God. Regardless of our human views of biology, whether male or female, even as facets of love overlap in many ways, the angels have an understanding of the differing forms of spiritual Love. All forms of love are within and from God.

As Lucifer contains the masculine form and Lilith the feminine, they found a synergy that made possible their devious union.

Before accepting Lucifer, Lilith tried to find where the Father had gone. In her search she had found a gap in the wall around heaven where she was able to go out into the void. There she thought she had complete privacy.

Lilith shared this spot with Lucifer and it was in this empty location that she fully revealed her anger and hatred to him. Once bonded in treachery, it was there that the two would scheme about their future rise to power.

In her closeness to Lucifer and her awareness of his stains from sin, she realized he was actually becoming weaker. In this dark location, through her gifts as a healer and spirit builder, together they realized she could provide Lucifer with nourishment from her own essence. From herself she could give him the power he had lost.

She began to feed him her own self to replace the nourishment that he had lost. In this act, not only did Lucifer become stronger, but he thought he also now knew how to control the life-source provided to others so that he could take it for himself to grow even stronger.

When he would consume her, Lilith began to have stains and blotches on her soul from giving herself to him. The sight of that excited her as she felt she was becoming the source of power for the one who would become more powerful than the Father.

Together they traveled down this delusional road. Soon though, they realized they needed more sources to continue to grow Lucifer's power. As Lilith looked upon him, she slowly began to see the alter ego of Satan coming together, and she liked the darkness into which it was growing.

Lucifer and Lilith now had the tools to convince others to turn from the Father, and also the avenue for growth in power. Still, they falsely believed that at some point Lucifer would be able to overthrow the Father, 'if' God returned, and then rule over all forever.

This terrible falsehood began the most horrible time in Heaven.

The Deception/Consumption

Together, Lucifer and Lilith worked diligently to mislead one angel at a time into thinking that the Father was the enemy. While Lilith would see their doubts and uncertainty regarding God, Lucifer would

then exploit those areas. He would say that the Father 'claimed' He would always be with them, but that was a lie because He had left. Lucifer would call the Father a selfish deceiver, and some would agree as the existence of the Holy Spirit was not yet understood. This would lead others to question the truthfulness of their creator, making them susceptible to the lies of both Lilith and Lucifer.

As this disruption in Heaven grew, the faithful angels would often look to Michael and Raphael for guidance. For the first time, angels began to recognize fear. They saw the darkness growing, their friends changing, and an evil power slowly rising. Heaven was being shaken by the increasing embrace of sin. While it had started off with just a few angels turning, more and more were beginning to question and doubt the Father's words.

Michael and Raphael remained staunch in their positions of faith and trust. Together they worked to lift the spirits of many that didn't want to change. At times they would gather to pray to the Father, calling out to Him for help, and asking for an end to the chaos that was slowly building.

It was in these times of prayer that the Holy Spirit first became noticeable to Michael and Raphael. It wasn't something they could easily explain to others, or had any tangible way to reveal, but they began to recognize that the Spirit of God was with the two of them. From this insight they knew the Father had not deceived them at all, but that God was more complex than any of them had understood. That in the infused whispers, they could hear God guiding them to stay strong and lead others to resist the evil that was enticing so many to turn from the Father.

It was also in these whispers that Michael and Raphael were refreshed. They were tormented by seeing those they love fall to lies of evil. It took a large toll on their spirits. When they were hurt and felt they had failed, the Holy Spirit would bring them comfort and a bit of strength to help them continue their good works.

These moments were more significant than either of them could have imagined at the time because of God's plan for the future. But before then, evil would make even more treacherous gains.

When around a quarter of the angels had chosen Lucifer over the Father the true ugliness began. The consuming of angelic essence, which had only been happening in the darkness of the void, would now become public.

Lucifer, with the vast group of followers that had become his minions, moved en masse towards the throne of God and the Cherubim that stood guard. There was a certain one that Lucifer had targeted. This was none other than the head Cherubim, the overseer of the five guardians of the throne of God. Together they stood at the top of seven steps that rose to God's throne, a location no other angels had ever dared to journey.

Lucifer walked to the bottom of the seven steps and looked at God's Throne with a lust for power in his eyes and spirit. As he stood and looked upward, one of the Cherubim moved to stand between Lucifer and the Throne, as if to prevent him from going any further.

Complete horror came over many of the faithful as they could not believe what they were seeing. Lucifers supporters were becoming maniacal with the thought that their leader was now challenging the Father and that his strength appeared to be that of a god. They falsely believed that they were right all along to choose his dark and devious ways, and they growled and hissed for more.

Lucifer then walked up to the sixth step and stopped. Standing before the massive Cherubim that stood in front of God's Throne. Lucifer stared at him... hungrily.

All the faithful angels looked on in a state of shock, fear and confusion. The evil angels hooted and hollered as they saw their leader do what seemed impossible. Lucifer then turned around and bellowed, "Look at these guardians, they have no power over me. I am the god of all now."

Michael stepped forward to rebuke him, but before he could get a word out Lucifer spun back around and grabbed the Cherubim with his right hand just below his heads. The Cherubim dropped its spear, and his stance went from one of strength to utter weakness with his knees bending, shoulder slumping, and head tilted down towards Lucifer.

Michael took a step back thinking Lucifer had gained a new unknown power, as they had all thought the Cherubim were untouchable. Before Michael or any of the faithful angels could even begin to realize what was going on, Lucifer began consuming the essence of the Cherubim before all in heaven.

The sight of this horrified all the faithful, as they had no idea this was even possible. Those that followed Lucifer knew exactly what was occurring, as each of them had already gone through the process. They celebrated with an angry and violent schadenfreude.

When Lucifer had completed consuming the Cherubim, he lifted his limp spirit up and threw him down to the floor of heaven. There he lay as all looked on. Slowly, everyone's eyes turned back to Lucifer, who was still standing on the sixth step. With the powerful essence feeding his spirit, he had gained a look of obnoxious thirst and hatred while feeling more powerful than ever before.

Even with this additional strength, all he could do was turn and lust at God's Throne.

Somewhere deep inside, he knew he could not take the seventh and final step. That if he did, it would be his demise. Some power, some force prevented him from going any further.

In addition, the other four Cherubim were not shaken by what they had just seen, God had prepared them unlike any of the other angels for what had just occurred.

They had been made aware of Lilith's trip to their leader and his decision to reject the Father. She had read his spirit, fed him lies, and convinced him to give himself to Lucifer. Their only challenge was the rule that the Cherubim cannot leave the throne of God on their own. Because of this, Lilith and Lucifer connived the plan to finally go public with their treachery and unnatural acts. This entire occurrence was a show to manipulate the angel's beliefs and to sow even greater fear among the faithful. For some time, their plan worked.

From a sparse understanding of the power that resided in God's Throne, as well as the rage that the other four Cherubim now had, Lucifer went no higher than the sixth step.

He turned back to the angels behind him and said, "Why would I want the throne of a fallen God, I will build my own in a place none of you know about."

With that declaration Lucifer came back down the steps and left the area. His minions, and many that had lost their faith during this exhibition, followed him away. This included the fallen leader of the Cherubim that had just been consumed.

It was only Raphael, the Archangel healer, that took notice of the continued existence of the Cherubim that had just been consumed. Being the Healing angel of God, seeing this and also receiving an infusion of guidance from the Holy Spirit, he began pondering and questioning what just actually happened. The horrific sight had now become more of a mystery to him, and he felt he could solve it through and with the Holy Spirit.

After all the evil had left, the location before the throne of God was once again filled with only the faithful. As their numbers were diminishing, the most heated debate arose amongst them about what they had just seen. They questioned what they could do about it, and what they should do next.

While there were few answers, the one decision they agreed on was to pray to God for help and His return. Together they called out, trumpeting their voices, though they were a bit meeker than before. Fear was beginning to overwhelm many of them and the uncertainty of the future made it even worse.

The Stand

It was through the Holy Spirit that the rules of their existence were imparted to Raphael early on. When they were initially created, all the angels were provided God's Law for their stations. At that time, they didn't fully understand the significance of each law or how encompassing they were.
