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National Nonprofit Petco Love Invests in Texas Litter Control to Help Increase Access to Veterinary Care for Pets in Harris and Surrounding Counties

Houston, TX (June 08, 2026) – Texas Litter Control is set to receive a \$20,000 grant investment from national nonprofit Petco Love in support of their lifesaving work for pets in Harris and surrounding counties.

Petco Love is a national nonprofit leading change for pets by harnessing the power of love to make communities and pet families closer, stronger, and healthier. Since its founding in 1999, Petco Love has invested nearly \$433 million in adoption and other lifesaving efforts. And Petco Love helps find loving homes for pets in partnership with Petco and more than 4,000 organizations — like ours — across North America, with more than 7.1 million pets adopted and counting.

The investment in Texas Litter Control is part of more than \$1.2M in grants recently announced by Petco Love for nearly 200 spay/neuter clinics and other low-cost veterinary care providers to help increase access to veterinary care for pets in their communities. The lifesaving investments are also being granted to reduce economic euthanasia, and the surrender of pets to shelters when families are not able to afford needed veterinary treatment.

“Petco Love knows pets are family and we strive to take care of them the best we can, though the reality is not everyone has equal access to veterinary care as many pet parents face difficult financial times,” said Chelsea Staley, President of Petco Love. “That’s why we are proud to support our partner animal welfare organizations in providing helpful services in their communities, so we can keep pets and their families together.”

“This Petco Love investment is a true blessing. Texas Litter Control took over the operation of the Greater Good Low-Cost Veterinary clinic at 1001 Dairy Ashford in the Houston Memorial on February 1st. They were being forced to close due to the doctor having a serious medical condition,” explains Deana Love, Executive Director and Founder of Texas Litter Control. “That was the first clinic I went to when I first started in rescue. Dr. Kuehl has helped so many people and pets. We just couldn’t allow his legacy to not live on. This investment from Petco Love is helping us update some equipment and add two additional wellness rooms to the practice, so we can continue with his lifesaving mission.”

As part of Petco Love’s mission to make pet families healthier and increase access to veterinary care,

through its *Vaccinated and Loved* campaign, Petco Love [reached a significant milestone of distributing four million free pet vaccines](#) for family pets in February 2026. The campaign was launched in 2021, encouraging Petco Love animal welfare partners to host free vaccine clinics.

Texas Litter Control is a nonprofit organization that provides high quality, low-cost veterinary care throughout Harris and surrounding counties. Affordable pet care is critical to keeping pets with their pet parents. Since 2013, Texas Litter Control has served over a quarter of a million pets! We have spayed and neutered over 220,000 pets, including over 50,000 outdoor kitties. We began in a small FEMA trailer. We now run four clinics (Spring/the Woodlands, Humble, Tomball and now Houston Memorial).
