his elderly mother Ruth, and their beloved cat, Aspen, whose journey from California to Texas took a heart-wrenching turn. Thanks to the Help Me Keep My Pet (HMKMP) program by Texas Litter Control (TLC), their story transformed from one of uncertainty and distress to one of hope and reunification, demonstrating the profound impact of targeted support in times of crisis.

Background:

Alex and Ruth, having recently relocated from California to Houston, were in search of a fresh start. After using their last resources to secure temporary accommodations at a local hotel, they faced an unexpected and devastating setback. The staff learned of Aspen and informed the family that due to hotel policy, their cherished feline companion was not allowed to stay. Faced with this unexpected predicament, Alex and Ruth were at a loss. Their options were limited, and the prospect of finding a solution for Aspen seemed bleak. The thought of being separated from their beloved pet was both heartbreaking and overwhelming.

The Intervention:

In their moment of need, Alex and Ruth turned to Texas Litter Control. TLC staff promptly directed them to the Help Me Keep My Pet program and instructed the family to fill out the online request form at helpmekeepmypet.com. The HMKMP team, dedicated to preventing pet homelessness and ensuring families stay together, quickly assessed the situation and stepped in to provide crucial support. Understanding the urgency of the situation, the HMKMP team and TLC staff worked together to ensure Aspen received the basic wellness services she needed to be placed in boarding. Once vetting was complete, she was moved to temporary placement, alleviating the immediate pressure and allowing Alex and Ruth the breathing room they needed to stabilize their situation.

Outcome:

With Aspen's care covered by the HMKMP program, Alex and Ruth were able to focus on finding stable housing without the added stress of their pet's immediate welfare. The assistance they received offered practical support but also provided emotional relief, allowing the family to navigate their transition with greater ease. After three weeks, Alex successfully secured an apartment where he, Ruth, and Aspen could be
