On Site Registration




Tech Sessions











We will have hoses and buckets available for you to wash your car on 9-14 Sept 2018 during normal business hours.



The Operations Center will have complementary light snacks and beverages for GoF West registered entrants.


The Operations Center will also serve as the Arts and the Craft Display area and this will be where you can vote for your favorite piece of art up until noon on Wednesday.





Sand Harbor Sunset BBQ







GoF West 2018 has reserved the Group Area at Sand Harbor State Park for the Sunset BBQ on 11 September 2018 starting at around 4:30pm and lasting until 7:30. The Group Area is set next to the lake; and has a covered veranda with 100 seats, and can accommodate groups of up to 200. The Group Area is equipped with electricity, water and tables, including two BBQs. We will have this event catered and will provide soft drinks. Alcohol is permitted but this will be a BYOB event.

It's about a 30 minute drive north of the Hard Rock Hotel Casino to Sand Harbor State Park. Upon entering the park just show your GoF West 2018 badge to the park aide and he/she will let you enter without a paying fee. After the driving past park kiosk, proceed straight ahead another 500 ft. and the group area will be on your right.

Vikingsholm Tour

Inspired by the original Wild Goose from the gilded age of Lake Tahoe, Wild Goose II is a 36 foot commuter style boat. She was hand-built from Philippine mahogany in Holland, Michigan by Grand-Craft. Wild Goose II is U.S. Coast Guard certified, and can comfortably accommodate up to 12 passengers. The Goose offers seating both inside and out, she even has a heated cabin for those chilly Tahoe evenings.

Cruises will be offered daily from 10-14 September departing the North Tahoe Marina at 2pm in Tahoe Vista. The Wild Goose II cruise will tour the north shore of Lake Tahoe and will last approximately 3 hours. Drinks and snacks will be available on board. The cost for the tour are \$65 per person. Recommend you arrive 30 minutes before departure. Tickets are available on the GoF West website, www.gofwest.org or at the Registration Desk for \$65 per person.

14"x19" prints and we highly recommend they be mounted or framed.


Entries will be on display in the Operations Center from noon on Sunday until noon on Wednesday when voting closes.

Car Show





The car show will take place on Tuesday 11 September 2018 from 9am-noon.

We request all vehicles parked in the GoF West 2018 roped off area to move their cars from that area by 8:00am.

We will have a photographer available to take pictures of each exhibited vehicle prior to parking in the roped off area. Volunteers will direct entries to their respective class areas.

We will have soft drinks available in the parking lot, and if you decided to sit outside, we recommend you wear sunscreen.

Voting will be cut off at noon and at that time cars will be released by our volunteers from the car show parking area.



What's a Valve Cover Race?



In valve cover races, each competitor must construct a vehicle using a valve cover from a car's engine. In our case, is should be an MG valve cover of any vintage. Usually, entries should have four wheels and can be decorated. The valve cover is powered by gravity. In a valve cover race, two or more racing vehicles are placed at the top of a specially constructed incline. They are released at the same time and the first to cross a finish line at the bottom of the incline wins the race. If you have seen or participated in a boy scout pinewood derby, valve cover races are very similar.

The valve cover races are scheduled from 9am –noon on 12 Sept 2018 in the rear parking lot of the Hard Rock Hotel /Casino. There will be two vehicles raced per heat and it can take up to three heats to determine a winner. We are planning to have it conducted as double elimination event. So start building your valve cover vehicles now!
