Dear Friends,

It is always so good to get back to a regular schedule in the fall. Our schedules may differ from person to person, family to family, but for the most part, fall brings a busier schedule that we had experienced throughout the summer months. There are tournaments, football, basketball, and volleyball games, practices, meetings, confirmation classes, Sunday School Class, worship, harvest, and more. Instead of sitting around a campfire and relaxing, we seem to be running from one thing to another – our calendars seem to fill up before we know it. Yet, are these busy days – this packed calendar making us more distracted than before? Are we so busy that we have to chose between multiple activities that are important to us? Are we so busy that we have had to sacrifice some things that are important to us?

In Confirmation, we are starting the year by learning about the 10 Commandments. The First Commandment is this: You shall have no other gods. Martin Luther's meaning of this commandment in his Small Catechism says this — "We are to fear, love, and trust God above all things." Most of us, when are reminded of this commandment probably think that we do not have other gods. We don't worship statues or idols. This is true, but anything that we make more important than God (even unintentionally) becomes our god. Are there things in your life that are more important than God? What are you intentionally doing to keep God first and foremost in your everyday life? I was once told that you can see who and what are important in a person's life by looking at their checkbook and their calendar.

It is convicting to think about the places in which we are distracted. It is important for us to keep ourselves in check. We have been given an amazing gift through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We have been given forgiveness, life, and salvation. It is a gift that we build our lives on – we trust in these promises that Jesus has given us. We are called to keep God number one in our lives – more important than anything else. We all fall short at times when it comes to keep God first and foremost but thankfully, we can start anew each day, and reset our priorities.

My challenge for you this month is this. 1. Remember the amazing gift of forgiveness, life, and salvation we have so freely been given. 2. Take some time and reflect on what is important in your life – where does God fit into the equation? And 3. Challenge yourself to changes if needed – to embrace those things that help you keep God important. I imagine you will find that when God is number one, all other things fall into place or at least you are able to face anything that comes your way.
