

## GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION



- Conference registration is mandatory for poster presentation.
- All submissions must be emailed to secretaryidathane2223@gmail.com.
- The topic should relate to dentistry in UG/PG/Clinician categories.
- Please ensure confidentiality is maintained. No names, hospital numbers, or other identifying information should appear in the presentation.
- Poster presentations will be judged on content, slide quality, clarity, time management, and clinical relevance.
- You will be notified via email or WhatsApp about your presentation's date and time.
- E-poster categories: 1. PG/Practitioner 2. Student.
- E-poster title: must not exceed 100 characters, including spaces.
- Use clear headings and ensure adequate spacing between sections.
- Images and graphics should be of high quality, well-labelled, and accurately described.
- Posters should be understandable without verbal explanation.
- Posters should feature a well-organised structure and layout with minimal text, ensuring readability from 5 metres away.
- Presentations must fit within one PowerPoint file (Microsoft PowerPoint), set to 16:9 aspect ratio with 1080 resolution, not exceeding 10 MB, in JPEG format, and in portrait orientation.
- Do not use slide transitions, animations, movies, or sound links.
- The maximum number of authors: two for a student e-poster, one for a PG/Practitioner e-poster.
- Each presenter will have up to 3 minutes, followed by a 2-minute discussion.
- The three best posters in each category will be selected. The author and co-author must be the presenting persons to receive the award.
- Delegates should bring their presentation in their own pen drive.

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
