

City of Kevil Monthly Meeting

March 6th, 2026 @ 10:00 a.m.

Attendance: Mayor Charles Burnley, Commissioners Walt Burnley, Bruce Romaine and Debbie Bridges, City Manager Tim Myatt and City Clerk Christy Bishop.

The City of Kevil met on March 6th, 2026 @ 10:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous meeting were read, Commissioner Romaine made a motion to approve the minutes and Commissioner Burnley seconded the motion, motion carried.

Minutes:

- The commission discussed cameras, out of 6 cameras only 3 are currently working. It was decided in the meeting to move forward with upgrading the camera system.
- Judge Todd Cooper discussed the Lowe's Community Impact Grant, he said the Ballard County Fiscal Court would like to nominate the City of Kevil to receive this grant. A motion was made by Commissioner Romaine, seconded by Commissioner Bridges to move forward with this grant, motion carried. Improvements mentioned were playground equipment, basketball court and goals, a pickle ball court and city cameras.
- Commissioner Burnley made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-03-06-01 Waste Water Treatment Facilities Project STAG Grant, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, motion carried.
- Commissioner Romaine made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-03-06-02 Waste Water Treatment Facilities Project HUD Grant, seconded by Commissioner Burnley, motion carried.
- Judge Cooper also discussed the 1st meeting to become a Nuclear Ready County is scheduled for March 10th, 7:30 am at Bluegrass Restaurant in LaCenter.
- Travis Holder spoke on the upcoming Ballard County Cities Meeting scheduled for March 16th, at 1:00 pm in Kevil at the Community Building to discuss Water and Waste Water Projects.
- The commission decided to move funds from the Kevil New Commonwealth Gas account into the Kevil Fire Station account to cover expenses to finish the new fire station.
- The city has contacted Kentucky Utilities about upgrading the street lights to LED, we are waiting on a quote.

Commissioner Bridges made a motion to adjourn, Commissioner Burnley seconded that motion, motion carried, meeting was adjourned.
