

City of Kevil Monthly Meeting

December 6th, 2024 @ 10:00 a.m.

Attendance: Mayor Charles Burnley, Commissioner Ronnie Rathman, Commissioner Tony Wiggins, Commissioner Bruce Romaine, Commissioner JoAnn Cooksey, City Manager Tim Myatt, and City Clerk Christy Bishop.

The City of Kevil met on December 6th, 2024 @ 10:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous meeting were read, Commissioner Wiggins made a motion to approve the minutes and Commissioner Cooksey seconded the motion, motion carried.

Minutes:

- Annexation at Amy Lynn and Boone Crossing was discussed waiting to hear back from the Jeter Group.
- Bid Approval on KY Utility Relocation project for Revell Construction, Commissioner Wiggins made a motion to accept the bid, seconded by Commissioner Rathman motion carried.
- Bid Approval on KY Utility Relocation project for Colson Excavating, Commissioner Rathman made a motion to accept the bid, seconded by Commissioner Wiggins motion carried.
- Discussion was had about putting a lien for unpaid water bills for Cheryl Banks, city clerk will move forward with that process.
- The city discussed the 1996-01 User Charge Ordinance and decided that there were revisions to be made, Article 6 Section 2 to read Water service shall not be reinstated until all fees and penalties are paid including a \$75.00 disconnect and reconnection charge, in addition the city will strike portion of Article 6 Section 4 "...for which the bill has remained unpaid for 45 days in the case of a monthly bill after it has been rendered"
- A motion was made by Commissioner Rathman that any properties 1 year or over with unpaid property taxes will be subject to a property lien by the City of Kevil, seconded by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried.
- The city will give a donation for Christmas to the Ballard Co Sheriff's office for a local family, motion was made by Commissioner Romaine, seconded by Commissioner Wiggins, motion carried.
- Commissioner Rathman made a motion to give the city employees longevity pay of \$250, seconded by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried.
- Gas Report - the city has some financial questions that need to be answered, also the city would like to obtain a copy of the New Commonwealth Gas company agreement and regulations between the cities with a definition of the gas company, the city clerk will work on getting these records.

Commissioner Rathman made a motion to adjourn Commissioner Wiggins seconded that motion, motion carried, meeting was adjourned.
