- Commissioner Rathman made a motion authorizing someone from the City will be at any and all City foreclosures in the future, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, motion carried.
- Discussion was had about the City Clerk Christy Bishop finishing her 2nd year of KMCA training, Commissioner Romaine made a motion to give the clerk a \$2.00 raise, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, motion carried.
- Commissioner Rathman gave the gas report, there are some financial concerns the city has and it has been addressed several times in the gas meetings, a motion was made by Commissioner Romaine that if New Commonwealth Gas can not give the City of Kevil the requested financial reimbursement breakdown requested the city will need to take control of the bank account and checkbook, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, motion carried.
