  New Liberty Church Rd, according to ordinance #2019-3 section 5.5 Property owners
  must get permission from Kevil City Council. Kevil City Council gives permission as long
  as all restrictions, guidelines, and evidence of ownership are given to the city.
- New 4-way stop sign is to be put up at 1st and Nucholls.
- Stop sign at Charles and Summers needs to be fixed.
- Water backing up on Tammy Waldon's property in Whispering Oaks discussion was had and it was determined to not be a city issue, but a property issue.
- Deliberations are ongoing with the distillery about water and sewer usage.
