Minutes:

- Rod Martin from Klingner gave a report on the UV project, everything is ready to move forward, he mentioned an increase in the contract agreement, increase is \$7500 the city will need to make a motion to move forward motion was made by Commissioner Wiggins and 2nd by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried.
- Todd Cooper came to let the city know the distillery is coming to Kevil, and thank Charles and Tim for all their hard work to help make that happen.
- Whispering Oaks sidewalks were discussed a final decision was made to not take the sidewalks from John Summers, Commissioner Rathman made a motion, 2nd by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried, the city will be sending a letter to Mr Summers to let him know this matter is closed, and the reasoning behind the decision.
- Employee raises were discussed, Commissioner Rathman made a motion to give 4% raises, Commissioner Cooksey seconded the motion, motion carried.
- Water rates were discussed, Commissioner Rathman made a motion to raise water rates by 4% across the board, Commissioner Romain seconded that motion, motion carried. The second reading will be June 13th, at 5pm.
