

Minutes of the Monthly Meeting for the City of Kevil

December 4,2023

Attendance: Mayor Charles Burnley, Commissioner Romaine, Wiggins, Cooksey, City Clerk Lindsey, & Tim Myatt

The City of Kevil met in regular session on December 4, 2023 at 10:00 am. Minutes of the previous meeting were read, Commissioner Cooksey made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Commissioner Romaine 2nd the motion. Motion Carried.

Minutes:

-Tim provided information he has received so far on the sidewalks in Whispering Oaks. Our Contact has been out for the Holiday weeks but stated he is in discussion with the legal department. We will wait to hear from him before proceeding.

-Commissioner Rathman reported the Christmas Dinner will be moved to Dec. 8th due to scheduling conflicts.

Sheriff Giles and Deputy Grief gave the Sheriff's report for October. They will also be taking donations for local families for Christmas. A motion was made for the City to donate \$250.00 to the cause. 1st by Commissioner Rathman, 2nd by Commissioner Cooksey. Motion Carried.

- The Commission was updated on the Animal Shelter saga on Richard Burnley.

-A motion was made to pay the city employees the annual longevity pay of \$250.00 in the month of December. 1st by Commissioner Cooksey, 2nd by Commissioner Romaine.

-A motion was made for Lindsey to establish a new bank account at FCB to collect customer deposits. 1st by Commissioner Cooksey, 2nd by Commissioner Romaine. Motion Carried.

-An update was provided on the progress of the new Fire Station and the amount of department calls. Electrical will start this week. The department has received 95 calls to date. 30% MVA 18% medical. 98% have been mutual aide. Reba had to be worked on, a new siren box was installed and the annual service was performed.

-Tim received info from the KLC during the meeting. Their recommendations are the same as previous. They recommend a neutral contract that is familiar with ADA compliances. The recommended compliances are based on the 2010 requirements. We will see a jump in premiums and it will not go back down. KLC is recommending we do not proceed with anything more until assessments have been made. They will send Tim contractor information that specializes in ADA requirements.
