

City of Kevil Monthly Meeting

Attendance: Mayor Charles Burnley, Commissioners Ronnie Rathman, Walt Burnley, Bruce Romaine and Debbie Bridges, City Manager Tim Myatt and City Clerk Christy Bishop.

The City of Kevil met on July 10th, 2026 @ 10:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous regular meeting were read, Commissioner Bridges made a motion to approve the minutes and Commissioner Burnley seconded the motion, motion carried.

Minutes:

- The city will send a final clean up notice letter to 198 Kentucky Ave.
- Manager Karen Hensley from BTC came to speak with the commission about community involvement and the opportunity to partner with BTC through an NTCA grant for a Kevil community project. The commission will meet at a later date to discuss a project for Kevil.
- Commissioner Rathman made a motion to accept the 2nd reading on Ordinance 2026-04 Prohibiting unsafe, unfit or hazardous structures, seconded by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried.
- Kevil was asked to name the new access road connecting Paducah Rd and Kentucky Ave. Commissioner Bridges made a motion to name the road Kevil Access Rd., seconded by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried.
- Tim spoke with a representative from KIA regarding House Bill 900 and the \$5.4 million in funding for the Kevil Wastewater project. The representative confirmed that everything is moving forward as planned, and we should be able to begin the project soon.

Commissioner Rathman made a motion to adjourn, Commissioner Burnley seconded that motion, motion carried, meeting was adjourned.
