Minutes:

- The City received an email from Todd Cooper stating that SB 63 passed stating that side by sides are allowed to operate on county/state roads, the city will need an ordinance for this.
- Discussion was had about property tax rates, Commissioner Burnley made a motion to raise property taxes 4%, seconded by Commissioner Romaine, motion carried.
- Tim gave a report that the Whispering Oaks 3 phase is complete.
