Minutes:

- Discussion was had about the non payment on a water bill at 242 College Dr, the city will move forward with a lien on the property.
- Commissioner Romaine made a motion to allow the city clerk to attend the KMCA Spring Conference in Paducah April 15-17, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, motion carried.
- The city discussed combining the Rural and City fire departments into one Fire Department, this topic is ongoing.
- Discussion was had about the playground at the city park, Magistrate Hedrick spoke on the county wanting to potentially help the city with funding.
- Dennis Fulfer from the PADD office will be in Kevil on February 11th for the annual site visit and meeting.
- Magistrate Hedrick spoke about the county's continued effort to help the City of Kevil with infrastructure and growth moving our direction.
